MEMO: Adding wolves to existing outfitter licenses

Dear Outfitter:

The Board has directed that all Idaho outfitters licensed for bear, cougar and those big game outfitters licensed for predator be licensed for wolves once a wolf hunting season is established.

Because, IDFG have moved forward with a wolf hunting season, we have their lead and moved forward in making this opportunity available to the industry so you may serve the public by providing this opportunity. Attached is your amended license adding wolves as a temporary authorization to the area description where you have been historically licensed for one of these other activities. This has been done administratively at no charge to you.

If for some reason, the wolf hunting is curtailed, obviously wolf hunting will be suspended on your license. It then would be removed administratively upon re-licensure next year. It would remain so until a new season established and then we would go through this process again.

You will need to contact your state and federal permit administrator to add wolves to your permit, if required. Due to the tenuous nature of this activity, we have contacted the significant number of partnering agencies in this regard.
