## Purpose:

To educate BLM and USFS administrators on the use of a State of Idaho OG-6 Land Manager Statement Form.

# Purpose of the OG-6 Land Manger's Statement

- State of Idaho Laws state that in order to be complete, a new outfitter license or outfitter license amendment application, must, in addition to all other requirements include the signatures of the affected state and federal land managers in all areas where an outfitter plans to utilize lands administered by the state or federal government.
- The OG-6 - Land Mangers Statement is the form used by all land managers to communicate their expectations and intentions to the IOGLB. By doing so, it creates the paper trail needed by the IOGLB to execute the license process.
- Often an outfitter will initially complete an OG-6 Land Mangers Statement form. However, it is the Land Manager's responsibility to see that it is completed and submitted properly.

# Note:

- The procedures, documents, and IOGLB's review and decision to issue a license may be considerably different, depending on the context of the application, and the number of agency(s) with jurisdiction involved. Therefore, it is helpful to IOGLB to have adequate information provided by the Land Manager on the OG 6 Land Managers Statement Form.
- It is important for BLM/USFS/ Land Managers to understand that that IOGLB is significantly dependent on their knowledge of the resource, demand and existing use in make licensing decisions.
