

MINUTES OF MEETING
STATE OF IDAHO
OUTFITTER AND GUIDE LICENSE BOARD
Tuesday, May 9, 1961
Hotel Boise
Boise, Idaho

PRESENT: All Board Members: Tillman McCurdy, Al Tice, and Jay Taylor

Discussion relative to the issuance of the 1961 licenses for the Outfitters and Guides opened the meeting. The following was adopted:

1. Use the Department of Fish and Game forms, making the necessary changes, eliminating "Fish and Game" and using "Outfitter and Guide License Board".
2. The matter of time being so short and it being so far into the season, it was agreed that any applicants for a 1961 License who furnished the proper Bond and had the application signed by the Forest Ranger and Conservation Officer in the area in which he intends to operate, and held a 1960 license, would be without further investigation issued a 1961 license by the board.

The second matter of business was that of Chairman of the Board and the need for same. McCurdy and Tice elected Taylor and Taylor accepted. Taylor was authorized to have the necessary forms printed and secure mailing lists of 1960 license holders to mail Application and Bond Forms out. The matter of a secretary was discussed. The advisability of retaining one on an annual basis was decided against. The outcome of the discussion was that Taylor would be allowed to use public secretaries or stenographers, as the need would be, to and until such a time that the work load could be determined and a feasible estimate of cost arrived at.

Discussion relative to expenses of the Board members was gone into. It was decided that each Board member would consider all factors. Expense items and amounts would be arrived at at the next meeting.

The next meeting was set for Tuesday, May 23 in Boise. Authorized travel by all members was approved, to wit:
