The meeting was opened by Taylor reading minutes of the prior meeting, which were approved as written.

The mail received since the last meeting was gone over. Applications were perused and handling instructions were given Taylor where necessary.

Considerable discussion relative to non-licensed boat-trip operators was held. It was definitely agreed that both the middle fork and main river of the Salmon River must be checked to insure knowledge of our law and our intent to uphold the provisions of it. Methods and time and place of checking were discussed.


Out of this it was agreed that where possible all flying of Board members would be done by Tice in his Cub or Navion. Where possible, or where more economical, Harry Clark of Clark Flying Service would be contacted.

Further agreement was reached on the fact that if any one of the Board members were to gain knowledge of an un-licensed operator, the knowledge would be taken up with at least one of the other Board members by phone and the course of action taken. It was fully agreed by each individual member that he would be in full accordance with decisions of the other two.

With the number of applicants and the volume of correspondence increasing each time, it was agreed that our next meeting would be held July 20 in McCall, and anyone was so informed who had questions for the Board.

Regular and special business being taken care of, the meeting was adjourned.
