MINUTES OF MEETING STATE OF IDAHO OUTFITTER AND GUIDE LICENSE BOARD Thursday, July 20, 1961 Shore Lodge McCall, Idaho

PRESENT: All Board Members

The meeting was opened with the reading of minutes of the prior meeting. They were approved as written.

Taylor, having brought the mail received since the last meeting, applications and correspondence was permsed. Regular action was taken and special instructions for Taylor was decided upon.

This meeting was held at the same place and time as the Department of Fish and Game Commission meeting. The Board, as individuals and collectively, had the opportunity to discuss the Boards activities, as well as Outfitter and Guide's Law with the Department Commissioners and Department Heads. This opportunity proved very beneficial from the standpoint of the Board members and was welcomed by the Commissioners and Department Heads of the Department of Fish and Game.

Discussions were again held relative to non-licensed operators, particularly those of the river trips. The action taken by Tice and Taylor relative to an operator named Elliot was discussed, this action being chartering of a plane for Taylor to Indian Creek to meet Tice for an interview with Elliot. Ellibt had departed Indian Creek just prior to the arrival time designated for the meeting of Tice and Taylor. It was considered a good experience from the standmeeting of Tice action and was justified to some extent, as we were able to discuss with boatment of one of our licensed operators (Lea Bacos) their status under the new law.

It was agreed that all members were to stay over night and continue discussions of applications the following moming, as well as seeking an opportunity to discuss the dateline on license issuing for 1962 with members of the Game Department. Accordingly, at 6:30 pm the meeting was adjourned to reconvene at 8:00 the next morning, Friday, July 21.

July 21 - 8:00 am

The Board reconvened. Having talked with various members of the Game Department and Commission, discussion continued on the dateline for 1962 license applications and on new applicants of 1961, that is, applicants who have not had licenses in the past.

There was a discussion of apprenticeship for guides took place. It was decided
