


WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 27, 1961


The meeting was brought to order and with the Board's return to their individual homes, time and distance known, expense sheets were drawn up, approved and vouchers drawn to cover them. In this manner all expenses of the Board for the year were paid. No outstanding indebtedness was left and the books were ready for audit without any accruals for the first calendar year period of the Board's functions.

At 10:00 the Board met with the Governor in the executive offices. After reading our rough draft and commenting thereon, Governor Smylie made an appointment for Taylor on Wednesday, January 3 to meet with Mr. Don I. Walker, Chief of the Bureau of the Budget to discuss the construction of the report and to arrange for the audit of the books.

The meeting with the Governor terminated at 10:45 a.m. This was the final adjournment of the Board with the next meeting set for Friday, January 19, 1962, at which time the report to the Governor would be ready.
