

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES LICENSE BOARD
Friday, February 23, 1962
Lewiston, Idaho

PRESENT: All Board Members

The meeting was opened with the reading of the minutes of the meeting of January 26 in Boise. The minutes were approved as read.

This was followed by a discussion of our report to the Governor and a presentation meeting with the Governor of Tice and Taylor on the 23rd of January.

The review of persons to be present at this meeting, their individual files were set out and anticipated procedures and questions to each were programmed. This topic was carried through lunch. Immediately following lunch the Board began its interviews. During the course of the afternoon the Board interviewed 17 different licensees and applicants.

To assist in some questions as well as to clarify for the Board their position relative to Snake River operators, Bob Irving, Area Supervisor, Department of Fish and Game was asked, and graciously consented, to be with us in the meeting. Mr. Irving in addition to questions to the Board and very comprehensive answers for the Board stated that he was extremely optimistic, very, very hopeful, and with all his will in favor of the licensing law that this Board administers. In addition he requested that we call on him at any time for help, assistance, or anything else that we felt that he could be of benefit to us.

After interviews were completed the Board discussed the printing and distribution to State officials and license holders the Board's 1961 report to the Governor. The type of copy, the method of distribution and printing was agreed upon. It is anticipated that this will be completed prior to our next meeting.

The Board also discussed an information folder to be printed for distribution throughout the United States relative to information on the Law. This was fully agreed to and a study of copy for the folder was to be made by individuals of the Board and submitted at the next meeting for formulation.

The time and location of the next meeting was discussed. It brought out the need for programing with the Forest Service. Along these matters it was felt the best way to approach it would be to have a "feeler" meeting and to take advantage of Supervisor Defler's, Payette National Forest, offer of assistance and to meet with him on or as close as possible for him to March 23 at McCall. Taylor was designated to correspond with Defler for confirmation of Friday, March 23 at McCall for the next meeting.
