June 22, 1962

PRESENT: All Board Members

The meeting was opened at 1:00 pm with the reading of the minutes of the prior meeting which were approved as read and signed.

Applications for new licensees were perused and instructions were given for license issuance, etc.


Taylor submitted his invitation to prepare and give a paper at the Western Association of Fish and Game Commissioner's Convention in Seattle with the requested title of What Part the Outfitters and Guides Play in Wild Life Management. The values to be derived as well as the expense of the trip were discussed and it was unanimously agreed that if this could be done for an outlay of less than \$125.00, it would be to the advantage of the Outfitters and Guides of Idaho, this Board and the State of Idaho as a whole.

Outfitter Ferg Nelson of Salmon came before the Board to recite his side of the game violation of which he is charged and which is of record. In view of what he told the Board, it was agreed that Taylor contact Supervisor McDermott to ascertain if there was anything further the Board could do to assist this man for his operation in 1962.

Wayne England, outfitter from North Fork, together with Mr. Yule, appeared before the Board. Mr. Yule, who is in co-partnership with two other men, has purchased a portion of Wayne England's operation and desired a license for operation as well as an opportunity to meet the Board and explain the program for the future of the co-partnership of which he is a member. The Board explained the limitations which would necessarily accompany licenses issued along with other factors relative to the policies, rules and regulations of the Board as well as definition of portions of the Law.

The place and time for the July meeting was set for Boise, Friday, July 20. Travel by West Coast Airlines was authorized by McCurdy; Taylor and Tice are to travel by car.

There being no further business for the current meeting, adjournment was made at 6:30 p.m.
