PRESENT: All Board Members


Because of extenuating circumstances with Tice, it was agreed that the meeting place be moved from Grangeville to Mackay Bar, with flight furnished by Tice to make it possible.


Routine business was taken care of and current correspondence was set up for answering, which completed the opening business of the meeting. Several complaints and rumors were discussed, as well as review of the visitations of Tice and Taylor in September and early October, which brought up the matter of visitations and/or inspections in other parts of the State. The need for such was without question. A trip was set up and travel authorized for Taylor from Mountain Home to McCurdy's camp and for McCurdy and Taylor to spend 2, 3, or 4 days in the Clearwater, Lochsa and Selway areas visiting as many camps and locations as possible. McCurdy and Taylor made arrangements as to the day of the meeting (noon, November 1) and McCurdy planned the itinerary from there. Before further such trips were planned, it was decided that evaluation would be made of this trip which would have a bearing on decisions for others.

The abundance of late applications combined with the plan of future operation made it mandatory to extend this meeting until the following morning (Saturday, October 27). The meeting was recessed until the following morning.

Following the morning meeting the meeting was adjourned. Tice returned McCurdy and Taylor from Mackay Bar.
