

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
STATE OF IDAHO
OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES LICENSE BOARD
December 11 - 16, inclusive
Shore Lodge, McCall, Idaho

PRESENT: ALL BOARD MEMBERS

The Board met on Tuesday, December 11 at 4:00 p.m. and during the balance of that evening and all of Wednesday, December 12, the routine business was attended to and plans were tentatively made for hearing license applicants on Thursday, December 13.

The secretary arriver at noon. Following lunch, the expense sheets of the Board were brought up to date and tuded by the secretary. It was unanimously agreed to that starting with January 1963, expense sheets would be submitted and payment made monthly.

Current correspondence and filing were brought up to date and the Board's activities during the Idaho Outfitters' and Guides' Association's three-day convention were discussed.

On Thursday, December 14, among those who met with the Board were: Frank Santos, Marcellus Smith, C. C. Horn, Walley York, Ken Strickler, Norm Adkins, Frances Zaunmiller and Loren Hollenbeak.

With reference to the operation of Jess Taylor -- Big Creek. Jay Taylor and Al Tice related conversations with the Forest Service, Johnson's Flying Service, as well as licensed outfitters questioning the Board relative to Taylor operating as an outfitter on a guide license. It was agreed that further investigation be made relative to Taylor's operation and hiring of nonlicensed guides, as has been reported. Further action is pending accumulation of evidence, etc.

In the case of Marcellus Smith (Clearwater Outfitters), the Board perused the complaints against him and heard his reply individually and collectively. The Board requested, after giving him the names of each and every one of the complaintants, that he contact them in an endeavor to settle these differences outside of Board action. At the same time it was requested that he have his past customers supply the Board directly with their opinions of the operation, personnel, etc., of the Clearwater Outfitters.






December 11 - 16, continued
