The Board received a report from Taylor that there was no knowledge of any activities in the Valley County Prosecutor's office in reference to the Floyd Posing case.


In connection with Jess Taylor, Harold Hanson of North Fork had called stating that a California man had purchased the Taylor Ranch, and that he, Hanson, was to operate it. With this in mind, pending receipt of a letter from the purchaser, we did let the Taylor case be dormant.


All pending applications were reviewed and marked for instructions to the secretary.

Following this Tice and Taylor reviewed for McCurdy the meeting in Mountain Home on Saturday May 25 with Marv. Hornback, Harold Dudley and Major Schamber in reference to the White Water Ranch, its leasing by Hornback to Schamber, the area for big game hunting in connection with it and the factors involving joint areas with surrounding established operators. At the Saturday meeting Dudley had made reference to an apparent commercial operation with no license operating from the Forest Service camp next to the White Water Ranch. This was discussed with McCurdy, who was asked to investigate from the Lewiston-Grangeville side relative to this nonlicensed, apparently commercial operation.

Before closing the meeting all bills outstanding were paid through May 31.

Plans for the next meeting were left to be arranged in a similar manner as this one.
