


MINUTES OF THE MEETING
STATE OF IDAHO
OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES LICENSE BOARD
September 8, 1963
Sheriff's Office - Lewiston, Idaho

As a follow-up of the Meeting of May 31 on the investigation of Floyd Harvey, Mr. McCurdy contacted Nez Perce County Prosecuting Attorney, Mr. Mosman. After a conversation with Mosman it was decided McCurdy should contact the sheriff's office and get someone to accompany him when he met the boat that evening.



Meanwhile, both Mosman and the Deputy Sheriff contacted Floyd Harvey. When McCurdy returned to pick up the Deputy Sheriff Mr. Harvey was present. So, instead, McCurdy met with Mr. Harvey, discussed the set up, fully explained the importance of Harvey's boat operator having a guide license (Elmer Earl, the guide, has a Coast Guard permit and does not think he needs a guide license).

Mr. Harvey promised that he would see that Earl did get a guide's license or get someone who did have a license. Mr. Harvey also said he had requested that guide license applications be sent him, and so far had not received one (Board records show that application forms were sent 4/10/63). Mr. McCurdy promised to see that applications would be sent (applications were sent by certified mail and a receipt was received, signed by Floyd Harvey, dated 9/10/63).

There has been no correspondence or action from Harvey since April 23, 1963.
