

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
Salmon, Idaho
JULY 14, 1964

This special meeting called in behalf of, and for HAROLD HANSEN of North Fork who has applied for a license of activity in commercial big game hunting as an outfitter in an area of activity already licensed to, in part, each of the following: Wayne England and Wallace Yule.

There were others present as observers, citizens with interest
Forest Service Personnel and Fish & Game personnel.

The meeting was chaired by the Executive Secretary. The problem of the Board being unable to license, in the interest of safety to the guest of the operators, all three applicants for the same area of activity. It was brought out that the Board is not against licensing in this manner providing the operators involved assumed the additional responsibility of keeping the others informed and working out, amongst themselves, the responsibility of not conflicting their hunting parties in the same location.

Both England and Yule agreed, when ask by the Board, if something could not be worked out so that every one could get on with the promotion and advertising of his activity. Both wholeheartedly agreed this seemed possible and that they were willing to do so.

Throughout the discussion wherein the whole background was brought out, the primary things were, as to the Board, that this is the same area that HANSEN had worked for England for two or more years.


That HANSEN did not want the area he had been licensed for in 1961 at all. That HANSEN could not go back working for the Flying B ranch where he had worked in 1962 as a license holder.

That HANSEN had been given camp site and grazing permit from the Forest Service for the period August 25th to September 25th for each year of 1961 and '62. How this one month duration could be considered basis for the entire hunting season is as yet unanswered.

Upon adjournment of the meeting it was stated by the chair that the parties involved were exert every effort to dissolve this difference as soon as possible and notify the Board of the outcome so it could make the necessary adjustments and allow HANSEN as much time as possible before hunting season for his promotion.
