

Meeting May 14, 1965, Boise

Pursuant to recess, the Idaho Outfitters and Guides Board met at 9:A.M. May 14, 1965.

Present were Al Tice, Arlie Johnson, Martin Capps and Jim Renshaw.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tice.

The Board again took up the question of Harold H. Hanson's application for an outfitters license.

Mr. Wayne England was questioned about his prior use of the Little Squaw--Eakin Cabin area, especially during the 1959-63 hunting seasons. Mr. Hanson, also being present, was questioned about his use of the area.

After again reviewing the exhibits and hearing the tape recorder, the Board discussed a possible solution of licensing Harold H. Hanson for the area applied for, with the area east of Eakin Ridge to be a joint area with Wayne England.

Both Mr. Hanson and Mr. England were asked if this would be satisfactory and both agreed to the joint area. The Board cautioned Mr. Hanson and Mr. England that in the interest of the public they should attempt to cooperate with each other.

Mr. Tice then moved that the Board issue Harold H. Hanson an outfitters license for the following area:

AREA FOR BIG GAME HUNTING. Beginning at a point the north bank of the Salmon River in T.24 N, R 13 E, B.M., which is approximately midway between the mouth of Fawn Creek and the mouth of Little Squaw Creek, thence on a line due north to Little Squaw Creek, thence up Little Squaw Creek to a point on Eakin Ridge approximately one mile south west of Eakin Point, in Section 23, T 25 N, R 13 E, B.M., thence north westerly to a point on Harrington Creek, thence down Harrington Creek approximately one mile, thence due south to Dwyer Creek, thence down Dwyer Creek to the Salmon River, thence up the north bank of the Salmon River to the point of beginning.

The area within the above-described area which is east of a line drawn from Eakin Point down Eakin Ridge to the Salmon River is to be a joint area with Wayne England.

Seconded by Mr. Renshaw, and passed unanimously.

The license was then issued, an explanatory letter was prepared and signed, and an order was prepared and signed, all of which were served upon Mr. Hanson personally. A copy of the letter and the order were given to Mr. England, and are also included in the minutes of this meeting.


Mr. Steve Jordan came before the Board to inquire about acting as a boat guide under his outfitters license. He was told that any outfitter could act as a guide unless he holds a limited license.


