

BOARD MEETING JANUARY 20-21, 1967
BOISE

A telephone call from Mrs. Renshaw informed the Board that member Jim Renshaw is ill and could not attend the meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 10 a.m. by Chairman Tice.

The first order of business was the reading of accounts payable. Mr. Johnson moved that the Board pay the expenses of Steve Boller who was the legal counsel for the Board at the McCall meeting. Second by Mr. Baughman and unanimously approved.

After reviewing the formal complaints filed by Wally York and Miss Gertrude Maxwell alleging trespass on their respective hunting areas by Nitz Bros. and a letter of reply received from Don Nitz, the Board decided that it would be necessary to hold a formal hearing on the matter. A letter was drafted to Michael Southcombe, Deputy Attorney General, asking him to initiate proceedings for such a hearing and suggesting that it be held in Grangeville on April 18, 1967. He was also asked to obtain the services of a court reporter.

The authority of the Board to license boat operators on Idaho lakes was discussed. It was decided to seek the opinion of the Attorney General on this phase of the law and to discuss with some of the North Idaho legislators the need for such licensing.

A formal complaint against Mr. George Matteson filed by Mr. Gerald Richie was reviewed. The Board found that the area which was allegedly trespassed by Mr. Matteson had been licensed to Mr. Richie, but in 1964 it was licensed jointly to Mr. Richie and Mr. Matteson. The Board could find no information concerning the reason for this change

in status. A letter is to be written to Mr. Richie asking for background information on this change, and he is to be informed that he may petition the Board to have the joint use designation revoked. The Board will again review the matter upon receipt of further information from Mr. Richie.

A letter from Mr. Harry S. Linn, Gibbonsville, Idaho was read. He stated that he is no longer in the outfitting business and that he wished to release his interest in the Sheep Creek and Allan Lake hunting areas to Mr. Bert Whipple, Wendell, Idaho.

Mr. Whipple is to be informed that an application for the Sheep Creek area would most likely be favorably received. However, the Allan Lake area has been issued jointly to Glen McFarland, Carmen, Idaho, and it would be necessary to get a release from Mr. McFarland.

The urgent need for a master map showing the areas of operation for all outfitters in the state was discussed. It was agreed by all that this project should receive top priority. Mr. Stephen W. Boller has done some preliminary work for such a map and it was decided to find out if he is interested in finishing the map.

Mr. Boller joined the meeting and he was receptive to the idea of carrying on the map work.

Mr. Johnson moved that in and for a consideration of \$1000 the Outfitters & Guides Board contract to Mr. Stephen W. Boller the preparing of a master map showing all of the outfitter hunting areas in the State of Idaho; said map to be made on a forest to forest basis on regular Forest Service maps furnished by the Board. Mr. Boller has agreed that he will put forth every effort to complete and deliver these maps to the Board office by June 30, 1967. Said \$1000 contract with Mr. Boller covers all phases of the preparation of this map other than actual and necessary travel expenses by Mr. Boller as may be approved from time to time by the Board as being necessary to the completion of said maps.

Mr. Martin Capps seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

The secretary was instructed to write the various Forest headquarters for maps.

The secretary was instructed to order new letterhead stationery and the necessary forms for the coming license year.

Mr. Tillotson had asked the Board to consider moving the Outfitter office to one of the other rooms in the building. After consideration the Board came to the conclusion that the present location is more suitable for our needs.

The meeting recessed at 5:30 p.m.

The meeting reconvened at 9:30 a.m., January 21.

The overlap of the areas of Larry Garner and Wayne England was carefully reviewed. All information was gathered together from the files of the Board and the Association files pertaining to the beginning of the area system. A decision was passed until it is possible to meet with Mr. England and Mr. Garner, either together or separately.

A few late licenses were approved, their issuance having been held up because applications were incomplete.

Approval of all licenses issued to date was reaffirmed as shown on the following list of licensees for the 1966-67 year.
