

BOARD MEETING SEPTEMBER 5, 1968

Boise

Mr. Dan Slavin was also present.

The purpose of the meeting was to render a decision in the Phelps-Santos boundary dispute and to take care of accumulated correspondence and license applications.

A letter was written to Mr. Joe Blackburn, Regional Conservation Officer, requesting his assistance in checking the hunting camps of outfitter Jim Taylor to determine if he is complying with stipulations agreed to prior to issuance of his license.

The request of Mr. Robert Griffiths for refund of his non-resident outfitter license fee due to the fact that he has closed down his operation was denied in compliance with 36-5408, Idaho Code.

An order for decision in the Phelps-Santos hearing was drawn up by Mr. Dan Slavin, giving the area boundaries determined by the Board, a copy of which is attached to these minutes. It was further determined that Mr. Robert Shawley has no substantial interest in the disputed area.

It was moved by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Baughman that Mr. Tom Thomas be informed that a completed application for an outfitter license would most likely be denied due to his operating without a license during the past 4 years. Further, that Mr. Norman Thomas is to be informed that if he makes application for renewal of his license, it would be denied due to his continued employment of an unlicensed guide, in accordance with 36-5413, Idaho Code. Unanimously approved.

It was moved by Mr. Renshaw and seconded by Mr. Guth that the renewal application of Mr. Elvin Hincks be denied for 4 reasons: 1) the remittance is in the form of a personal check; 2) he did not submit the late filing penalty; 3) the area is previously licensed to others; and 4) he must send a written release from the present licensees. Approved unanimously.

Another letter is to be written to Mrs. Edna Jackson regarding payment of the late filing penalty.

A letter is to be written to Jesse Rice informing him that his campsite at Chateau Rock is not within his licensed area and for that reason it would be illegal for him to operate from that camp. He is to be further advised that if he would submit an application for the area, defining its boundaries, the Board would give it their consideration.

The application of Merle G. Robinson for an outfitter license was denied because the area requested is licensed to a number of outfitters. His personal check is to be returned as instructions state that no personal checks will be accepted. At a meeting with the Board in June Mr. Robinson had been encouraged to contact present licensees and make a working arrangement with them before submitting an application. He had stated that he would get recommendations from the Fish & Game Dept. and the Forest Service, but he failed to do this, also.

The application of Glenn Schubert was reviewed. His application says he will hunt the Clayton Watson area. Letters of July 11 to Clayton Watson and August 9 to Mr. Schubert have not been answered. The subsequent death of Mr. Watson

makes it necessary for the Board to make further inquiry before transferring the rights for big game hunting in that area. For this reason, Mr. Schubert's license was approved to be issued "Not valid for big game hunting."

A letter from Mr. Raymond Tarbox, dated August 19, was reviewed. He was objecting because he had not been licensed to outfit in the entire area for which he had applied, specifying certain areas where he desired to have camps. He is to be advised that the Board will reconsider his area of operation and include the sections mentioned in his letter except the portion in unit 9 which is licensed to Floyd Weddle, providing that he return his license so the description can be changed. The area presently described on the license would be deleted.


