

IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD MEETING

BOISE, IDAHO

July 1, 1969

Members Present: Rex Lanham, Chairman
James Baughman
H. W. Guth

The Board met in regular session for the purpose of reviewing license applications and any other business which might be brought before it.

Mr. Baughman reported that Mr. Charles E. (Bud) Grotzinger did not appear at the formal hearing set for June 30, 1969. He made a motion that Mr. Grotzinger's outfitter license be revoked for a period of 1 year due to his conviction for killing elk in a closed area. Seconded by Bill Guth and unanimously approved. Mr. George Detweiler is to be asked to draw up the order of revocation.

Mr. Rex Lanham moved that the salary of the secretary, Lois Merritt, be raised to \$450.00 per month retroactive to June, and further that additional office help be secured as needed @ \$1.80 per hour. Motion seconded and unanimously approved.

The meeting recessed for lunch until 1:00 p.m.

A meeting of eastern Idaho outfitters and guides and interested people is to be set up as soon as our attorney can draw up papers required for a formal hearing around July 30, 1969. The Secretary is to call headquarters of the Targhee and Caribou National Forests and Fish and Game Department and explain the purpose of the meeting and invite them to submit recommendations and also attend the meeting. Notice of the meeting is to be published in the Idaho Falls Post Register and a notice sent to all current licensees and applicants.

Because of request for transfers of areas on the Middle Fork of the Salmon River and the overlaps in areas as presently licensed, it was decided to hold a formal hearing before approving any transfers. Notice of the hearing is to be published in a newspaper and notices sent to James E. Muscutt, Albert Lamper, Dr. G. A. Bacon, R. G. Hetherington, J. Spencer Parker, Scott Farr, K. R. Strickler and Flying Resort Ranches, Inc. Time and place of the hearing to be 9:30 a.m., August 12, 1969 at the office of the Board, Boise, Idaho.

Also acting on the request of George L. May for an area review and the request of Wayne England for a transfer of his area to Nez Perce Outfitters and Guides, Val Johnson and Steve Mealey, the Board called for a formal hearing and area review for the following outfitters and applicants: George L May, Flying Resort Ranches, Inc., Wayne England, Dave Giles and Recreation Industries, Inc. d/b/a/ New Perce Outfitters and Guides. The Hearing is to held on August 13, 1969 at 1:00 p.m. at the office of the Board, Boise, Idaho.

A motion was made by Mr. Baughman and seconded by Mr. Guth that \$15,000 be placed in 90 day certificates of deposit in the Commercial State Bank, Boise. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

A letter from Mrs. Archie George inquiring about the licensing of women as guides was reviewed and answered. She was told that women who are responsible for guests should be licensed. An outfitter employing a woman guide should use discretion in assigning duties within her capabilities.

Tentative areas were drawn up in the Pahsimeroi and Little Lost River Valleys for Ramshorn Ranch, Paul Wolfley, Gary Madsen and James Waymire.




