

FORMAL HEARING IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

August 13, 1969

August 13, 1969, 9:30 am, Members present: James Baughman & H. W. Guth.

The formal hearing for C. E. Grotzinger was not held as a result of action brought in the District Court.

Mr. Baughman and Mr. Guth reviewed applications until noon.

Formal Hearing convened at 1:30 pm with Mr. Baughman & Mr. Guth representing the Board and Mr. Detweiler acting as Hearing Officer.

Outfitters present were: George May, Dave Giles; Flying Resort Ranches, Inc. represented by H. W. McNeal, Skip Carbon, Roger Thompson; and Recreation Industries, Inc. represented by Val Johnson, Steve Mealey and attorney, James Herndon.

The hearing was called to order by Mr. Detweiler.

Mr. Baughman stated the purpose of the meeting was to resolve area overlaps and establish area boundaries for new applicants.

Each outfitter was sworn and made a statement for the record, recorded on tape.


Mr. McNeal read a letter into the record, a letter sent to the Board on May 6, 1968, in which he explained the accomplishments and plans of Flying Resort Ranches and their need for additional big game hunting areas.

Testimony was taken from each outfitter who was licensed for Grass Mountain and an effort was made to determine the actual use by each.

The recorded statements would be studied by the Board and area boundaries established as nearly as possible in accordance with the use made of the area.
