

IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD MEETING

August 14, 1969

Boise, Idaho

Members present: Rex Lanham, Chairman; James Baughman, H. W. Guth.

The hearings of the previous 2 days were reviewed and new boundaries drawn for the following outfitters and applicants:

The new boundaries were placed on the master maps. Orders are to be drawn up and licenses issued in accordance with these boundaries.

Mr. Guth made a motion that Board members should be compensated for  $\frac{1}{2}$  days when 4 hours or less are spent on Board business and  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours or more would be considered a full day. Seconded by Mr. Lanham. Unanimously approved.

Recessed for lunch until 1:00 p.m.

Mr. Norman Thomas appeared before the Board in regard to obtaining an outfitter license. Complaints against his services were reviewed with him, particularly \$900.00 paid to him by John Cunningham and the hunt was cancelled without a refund. Mr. Thomas gave a number of references and he said Mr. Cunningham had agreed to hunt with him this year. A telephone call to Mr. Cunningham brought the response that he wanted his \$900.00 refunded and then he would consider a hunt with Mr. Thomas this year. Mr. Thomas's horses were sold at sherriff's sale twice in the last six years. Mr. Thomas was told the Board would have to make further inviestigations and the matter was tabled. He did not submit an application at this time.

Applications were reviewed.

Bob Ferguson's request for additional area was denied as we had a number of requests from new applicants for licenes for that vicinity.

Max Bitton was licensed for both areas applied for in Stanley Basin upon the recommendations of Mr. George Presley, District Forest Ranger.

Transfer of Warren area from Louis Rebillet to Del Davis was approved.

Transfer of the area north of the Old Landers Trail in Unit 76 from Dave Giles to Merle Robinson was approved.

The Wilkerson Creek area was divided between Maynard Holcomb and Martin Capps upon the recommendations of Robert Shackelford, District Ranger.

Transfer of the Ben Lefler area to Bobby Ray Crick was approved after deleting the Middle Fork of Kelly Creek which has been an overlap with Mr. Gulli. He was licensed for additional open area in the vicinity of Hanson Ridge.

The licensed area of Robert L. Stinnet was revised in accordance with an agreement signed by him whereby he released approximately 3 miles up from the Snake River shoreline to be licensed to Ralph Page for hunting from the river.

Granted an outfitter license to J.M. Smith for fishing only on hazardous rivers.

The application of Dr. G. C. Barlow, d/b/a St. Joe Lodge Co., included the area formerly licensed to Gene Francis and released by him. The East boundary was revised to coincide with the west boundary of Carl Nagel. On the west, an adjustment was made to remove an overlap with Jim Kusler.




