

IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD MEETING

September 3,4, 1969

Boise, Idaho

September 3, 9:00 a.m.

Members present: James Baughman, Vice Chairman; H. W. Guth, R. J. Holmes

The purpose of the meeting was to review applications on file, answer correspondence and work on rules and regulations.

A letter from Mr. Arnolt Oswald to Governor Samuelson was reviewed. He requested the governor to intervene in procuring additional area. A letter was written to the governor with a copy to Mr. Oswald explaining that the area requested is already licensed.

Complaints against Mr. Strickler were reviewed. Mr. Strickler has made a partial refund to Mr. Teskey and party which satisfied Mr. Teskey and the bonding company and a new bond was issued for Mr. Strickler. He has agreed to reduce his operation by 20% and the Board voted to renew his license.

Mr. Holmes made a motion that when complaints are received against an outfitter or guide he should be notified as soon as possible and the charges against him listed. Seconded by Mr. Guth and unanimously approved. When complaints are referred to us by the Fish and Game Department they should be acknowledged and a copy sent to the outfitter.

Recessed for lunch until 1:30 p.m.

Minutes were read for meetings of February 11, 12, 13 and April 15,16 and 17. Approved as read.

Incomplete applications were reviewed and instructions given to secretary Lois Merritt, where action is warranted.

Gerald Richie is to be requested to submit a bond so that his application will be complete. Also, Whalen Lilly is to have a similar letter, others are to have final notice that their applications are not complete and licenses cannot be issued.

Mr. Robert Hall appeared to present his credentials as the new secretary for Selway Wilderness Ranch, Inc. and requested that the license be issued to him. The license has previously been in the name of Rolla Briggs and he has submitted his application for renewal.

Emmett Rynearson's license was issued to include area between the Lochsa and Selway Rivers released to him by Harry Vaughn for the 1969-70 season.

David Jenkins requested and received a license as outfitter and guide for back packing trips, no big game hunting.

Homer Rhett was issued an outfitter license to operate the Crofoot Ranch upon a release from Frank Santos.

Robert M. Smith applied for an outfitter license for the area formerly licensed to Dick Fortin and the Indian Hill area formerly licensed to Selway Outfitters. The District Ranger refused to issue camp permits for him to use the Indian Hill area. For this reason and because he is a new operator, his license was issued for just the Fortin area.

The application of Melvin Ezell for a new outfitter license was approved but the area was revised to eliminate an overlap with Dr. Barlow on Silver Creek.

A license was approved for Joe Adams and the big game hunting area was revised to eliminate portions already under license.

The application of Ralph Page to expand his boatman's license to include big game hunting was approved for approximately three miles up from the Snake River shore line released to him by Robert Stinnett.

Mr. Jim Taylor's application was approved with a reminder that he is still bound by the terms of his probation. Attorney Homer Martin appeared in his behalf.

The Agreement made between Louis Wooley and Moose Creek Ranch Co. at the meeting at Salmon on May 17, 1969, resolving their boundary dispute, was approved by the Board. The transfer of the Floyd Hanson area to Moose Creek Ranch Co. was approved.

The application of Harry Vaughn was approved for his old Bimerick Creek area and the Locksa-Selway area east to West Fork Gedney Creek and north to Old Man Creek, formerly licensed to Selway Outfitters. The Indian Hill and Mink Point areas were not approved as we have a number of applications on file from outfitters adjacent to these areas.

The application of James Waymire for an outfitter license to operate north of Howe was approved after adjusting the area so that a number of other operators could be licensed in the Pahsimeroi and Little Lost River. These included Paul Wolfley, Ramshorn Ranch, and Gary Madsen.

Mr. Robert Hall submitted an application, bond and map for an outfitter license for Selwy Wilderness Ranch. Since the corporation is involved in litigation among the stockholders, the application was tabled awaiting developments.

The license of Phillip Johnson was issued for the same area at 1968-69 as the Muley Creek and Peach Creek area applied for has not been released by Mrs. Beulah Reeves.

The Board approved the release of the Opal Creek and Rams Creek drainage by Ken Strickler to be used by Ramshorn Ranch for the 1969-70 season.




