

IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

March 10-11, 1970, Boise, Idaho

Board members present: H. W. Guth, Jim Renshaw, and R. J. Holmes.
Absent: Rex Lanham, chairman, and James F. Baughman.

Al Tice appeared to discuss the transfer of his big game hunting rights to the Mackay Bar Corporation and L. A. Fatouras.

A complaint against Bob Hetherington was reviewed. It concerned a deposit which had not been returned when the client cancelled the hunt. The complainant is to be told this is outside the purview of this Board, but that it is not customary in the outfitting industry to refund deposits.

Recessed for lunch until 1:30 p.m.

The meeting reconvened with Chairman Rex Lanham present.

An outfitter license for E. L. Nichols was approved.

A motion was made by Jim Renshaw, seconded and unanimously approved that the Board buy a used adding machine.

The remainder of the day was spent in designing new license application forms.

The meeting recessed at 5:00 p.m. until 9:00 a.m. on March 11.

The meeting reconvened with the same member present.

The Board discussed the necessity for Mike Wilkins to get a telephone.

Further work was done on the license applications. The signature of the District Rangers will not be required. A letter should be sent to the Forest Service, Mr. Shaw in Region IV and Mr. Worf in Region I, explaining this change. Copies should be sent to all supervisors.

George Detweiler called and said the governor had signed the bills revising the Outfitters & Guides Act. The secretary was instructed to obtain all information relative to implementation of changes which will be required by the new law.

The meeting recessed for lunch until 1:30 p.m.

An outfitter license was approved for Larry Walker for bear hunting, only, in the Dubois-Island Park area which is licensed to A. W. Angell for big game hunting. Approval from Mr. Angell was obtained by Mr. Baughman via telephone.

The transfer of the Lee Manes area to H. H. Hepburn was approved.
