May 20, 1970, Boise, Idaho

Board Members present: James Baughman, Jim Renshaw

Since a quorum was not present, no official business could be conducted. However, Mr. Charles Grubin and Mr. Norman Riddle, accompanied by their attorney, Mr. Mack Redford, wished to make application for licenses. With Mr. Baughman conducting the meeting, they presented their case. Mr. George Detweiler was also present.

Chairman Lanham joined the meeting so a quorum was present, Mr. Guth also arrived.

Mr. Grubin and Mr. Riddle wished to get an outfitter license for Snake River Outfitters and boat on the river and take hunters in the area which Max Walker had applied for. They were told that they have guide licenses which are valid until June 30, 1970; they can continue to operate and the Board will review their applications.

Mr. Walt Sundell and Mr. Gary Flanik of the Forest Service appeared to discuss the Jim Taylor operation. They feel that Mr. Taylor has not been serving the public in a satisfactory manner, judging from the complaints received.

They also said Mr. Stan Miller who was manager for Middlefork Ranch Co. last season, would like to have an area on Pungo Creek which is in the licensed area of Middle Fork Ranch Co. They feel that there should be a larger harvest and would like to give him a campsite. The Board said they would consult with the present licensees and inform the Forest Service.

Board members expense accounts for March, April, and May were approved to be submitted to the auditor.

The meeting adjourned at 1:00 p.m. to allow attendance at the public meeting of the Fish and Game Commission, setting the big game closing dates.

The meeting reconvened at 4 p.m. for further discussion of application of Snake R. Outfitters as they are requesting immediate action. No further action taken. Meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
