

IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

June 4 & 5, 1970, Boise, Id.

Members present: James F. Baughman, Vice Chairman, Jim Renshaw,  
H. W. Guth.

The meeting was called to order at 9:10 a.m. The minutes of previous meetings were read and approved with additions as noted.

There was a discussion regarding assistance in enforcement by the Fish & Game Department. Mr. Baughman had met with Mr. Woodworth and other officials to enlist their help and cooperation, which they had previously indicated they would be willing to provide. They asked us to provide lists of licenses as they are issued and they would need 80 copies for their officers. The Board such lists prepared starting with July 1.

The meeting recessed for lunch and reconvened at 1 o'clock.

Applications for licenses were reviewed until 5:30 p.m. and the meeting recessed until 9:30 a.m. the following morning when Mr. Holmes was also present.

Applications were reviewed until noon when the meeting recessed until 1:30 with Chairman Lanham present, making a full Board.

Mr. George Detweiler appeared to request the Board to issue the outfitter license to Snake River Outfitters. The Board approved and issued a boat outfitter license to Snake River Outfitters and boat guide licenses to Charles Grubin and Norman Riddle.

Mr. Detweiler was asked to review the boat guide license fee required from Utah residents as requested by boat outfitter Don Hatch. He will also review the outfitter application for Double K Outfitters, Inc. and the complaints against outfitter Jim Taylor.

It was decided to interview Mr. Cecil Sanford, St. Maries, as a possible investigator for the Board. He has recently retired from the Fish & Game Department.

The Board has been notified that the Idaho Commission on Federal Land Laws will hold an inter-agency meeting at Priest Lake on June 18 and 19. Mr. Holmes made a motion that all board members be authorized to attend. Seconded and approved.

It was decided to hold a meeting in Lewiston on June 17 and in Coeur d'Alene on June 19, to acquaint outfitters and guides and

prospective licensees of requirements under the revised Outfitters and Guides Act. The secretary was instructed to make the necessary arrangements and send out notices to the area newspapers.

Jim Renshaw made a motion that Jim Baughman be compensated at the usual rate for 2 half-days spent on Board business, at the office on May 27 and at the Fish & Game office on June 2. The motion was seconded and passed.

The Fish & Game violation of Cliff Cummings was discussed and it was decided to meet with him and the Conservation Officer before issuing a 1970-71 outfitter license, should he make application.

The request of Albert Lamper to have an area listed on his license for sheep and goat hunting was tabled until such time as we could review the tape of the meeting at which area adjustments were made for outfitters in the Middle Fork area.

The following licenses were issued, after which Mr. Holmes moved for adjournment at 5:30 p.m. Seconded and passed.
