

IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD MEETING

Boise, Idaho

August 13, 14, 1970

Members present: J. F. Baughman, vice chairman, H. W. Guth, Jim Renshaw and R. J. Holmes.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by the vice chairman.

The first business was to write a check in the amount of \$1,035.84 in favor of the State Treasurer, to close out the account in the Bank of Idaho.

The Board discussed the purchase of badges for our investigators and approved the design.

A telephone call was made to Norman Riddle concerning the formal hearing requested by his attorney in the matter of a big game hunting area for Snake River Outfitters. Mr. Riddle stated that he had bought out his partner, Charles Grubin, and that he wished to withdraw the request of a hearing.

The application of Lawrence Sullivan was reviewed. He has applied for area licensed to Maynard Holcomb which makes it necessary to deny his application. However, Mr. Guth has discussed this matter with him and he has requested that his license be issued for fishing, trailrides and summer pack trips. This was approved and the license issued.

Steve Jordan's application was again reviewed. The Board considered that he had been given sufficient time to submit statements concerning the need for a greater game harvest in the additional areas he had requested at his meeting with the Board on July 2, 1970. His license was issued for the same area as in 1969-70.

The application of Gene Nichols was reviewed. The big game area requested included additional area around his ranch in Rooker Basin. Part of this is already licensed to Ted Strickler. After deleting that portion, the remaining open area was approved for Mr. Nichols and his license issued.

A letter from Marilyn Ann Mueller was reviewed. She questioned the need for a guide to have a license when conducting trail rides is the only activity involved. She is to be informed that the Board construes the law to include this activity even though the definition of a guide does not specifically include it. The intent of the legislation as stated is to regulate and license those persons who undertake for compensation to provide equipment or personal services to those who participate in the enjoyment of our mountains, rivers and streams and the fish and game therein.

The application of Max Walker was approved for the big game hunting area above the breaks on the Snake River from Corral Cr. up to Granite Cr.

Chairman Rex Lanham arrived.

Recessed until 1:00 p.m. for lunch.

Applications were reviewed and licenses issued until 5:00 p.m. when the meeting recessed until 9:00 a.m. on August 14, 1970.

Members present were Chairman Lanham, J. F. Baughman, Jim Renshaw and H. W. Guth.

Rules and Regulations were discussed. Licensees will be required to carry their licenses or they could be subject to arrest. A new license will be issued for a nominal sum if the original is lost or destroyed.

A new license was issued to Wally York and he is to be billed for \$2.50

The application of Rick Hussey for an outfitter license for the area formerly licensed to Scott Farr was tentatively approved, but he is to be asked to meet with the Board for further questioning on September 10.

The meeting recessed for lunch and reconvened at 1:00 p.m. Chairman Lanham did not attend the afternoon session.

Andy Finn, Colbalt District Ranger, sent information to the effect that ^{LeRoy} LeRoy Pruitt had on two occasions refused to let boatmen on the Middle Fork share the campground he was using. He is to have a letter asking him to reply to these accusations.

Outfitters who held 1969-70 licenses and have not made application for a 1970-71 license are to be notified via certified mail that under changes in the law the big game hunting areas formerly licensed to them are now open to application and applications will be considered in the order of their receipt. Outfitters notified: Bob Ferguson, Lyle Phelps, Howard Miller, Wayne Twitchell, Paul Wolfely.

The next meeting was set for September 10 and 11, 1970.

The meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
