

IDAHO OUTFITTERS & GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho, September 10-11, 1970

Members present: J. F. Baughman, H. W. Guth, R. J. Holmes, and Jim Renshaw

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Baughman at 9:30 a.m.

The first matter brought before the Board was information from Dale Baird of the Fish & Game Department and John Hougaard of the Salmon National Forest to the effect that Ken Strickler had placed a party of 4 sheep hunters in an area far from any open sheep hunting. A further investigation is to be made by Mike Wilkins.

The incomplete applications of Jack Lykins and Gerald Richie were reviewed. They are to be notified that they must complete the application forms and submit them to the Board or the areas for which they have been licensed will be declared open for applications.

Rick Hussey appeared before the Board and offered assurances that he would take every precaution to be sure that his employees observe all fish and game and outfitter and guide laws. His outfitter license was issued.

The meeting recessed for lunch and reconvened at 1 p.m.

Loren Weston appeared and discussed his plans to outfit for duck hunters. He submitted his application, fee and credentials and was given tentative approval pending receipt of the necessary bond.

The available area in the Payette N.F. was again reviewed and it was decided that Homer Prock should be given an opportunity to apply for some open area southeast of Hazard Creek and that Larry Walker should be licensed for the Loon Creek-Secesh area. Since Homer Prock did not apply for this particular area he is to be asked to attend the next meeting of the Board on September 28 to determine if it would be of any benefit to his operation.

Ernest McBride's application for the Glen McFarland area was reviewed and approved after deleting an overlap with Cliff Cummings at Hughes Creek and with Dale Ney on Sheep Creek.

The meeting recessed at 5:30 p.m. until the following morning at 9 a.m. with the same members present.

It was noted that the bond submitted by Lorin Smith was on the old form and for the wrong amount. He is to be notified that his license is invalid until an adequate bond is posted. Since he is a boatman on the Salmon River his activity for this year is over.

License applications were reviewed until noon when the meeting recessed until 1 p.m.

Chairman Lanham joined the meeting after lunch.

A letter from the Personnel Commission was read, recommending classifications and salaries of employees. Mr. Renshaw made a motion that this recommendation be approved as follows: Lois Merritt to be classified as chief clerk, pay grade 15, step 3, at \$527 per month; Frances Nelson to be classified clerk typist II, grade 6, step 2, at \$1.86 per hour on a part time basis. The motion was seconded and carried.

The application of Hurbert J. Wagoner was reviewed. He applied for area already licensed to Stanley A. Sweet in addition to the area he was licensed for last year. It was necessary to deny this request for additional area.

John O'Connor's application for a guide license requested boating. His outfitter employer is Albert Lamper who is not licensed to boat. Mr. O'Connor's license is to be issued without boating with the explanation that this will be reviewed if he is employed by a boat outfitter at a later date.

The guide license of Dan Lord was approved for boating upon receipt of a notice from Dale Ney that Mr. Lord is now in his employ instead of that of Mr. Harold Hanson as shown on his application as originally submitted.

The Board approved 2 days salary for Board business done by Mr. Baughman outside of Board meetings on 7/23, 29, and 8/17. Motion to approve made by Jim Renshaw, seconded by Bill Guth.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m. with the next meeting to be September 28.
