IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD MEETING

September 28, 1970

Boise, Idaho

Members present: Chairman Rex Lanham, J. F. Baughman, and H. W. Guth

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairman Lanham.

A call from Mr. Wilkins reported that Norman Thomas has a camp all set up preparing to operate when the season opens. He has not completed his license application as he hasn't submitted a bond nor the late filing fee. He is to be notified that he will be in violation of the Idaho Outfitters and Guides Act if he operates without first securing a current outfitter license. Mr. Wilkins had also received information that Clyde Painter and Dick Sterling were prepared to take hunters into the McReynolds area.

The Budget was reviewed and approved for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1971.

The meeting recessed until 1:00 p.m.

License applications were reviewed. A small area south of Highway 93 near Clayton was approved for Vernon Johnson.

The application of Rex Moyle for big game hunting in the area formerly licensed to Bob Ferguson was denied as all available areas had been allocated to others who had submitted applications prior to Mr. Moyle's. He is to be notified that there is a small open area in the Seven Devils and suggest to him that he investigate the possibilities there.

An outfitter license for Dare Anderson was approved along the Lemhi River from Mill Creek to Meadow Lake.

The request of Thomas Thompson to extend his area southerly to Willow Creek was reviewed. The Board felt this would make his area too large for his operation, but agreed to extend it to include Willow Creek if he would release an equivalent area on the north.

Bill Guth made a motion that the Board have the two center pages of the Idaho Outfitters and Guides Association pamphlet for \$250. Seconded by Mr. Baughman. Motion passed.

The secretary was authorized to purchase two new filing cabinets. The salary for Mr. Baughman was approved for 2½ days spent on Board business outside of regular meetings---9/3,12,16, 1970. Motion to approve by Mr. Guth seconded by Mr. Lanham.

Norman Thomas is to be notified that we do not have his bond nor the late filing fee required by Idaho Code 36-5408 (3).

Attached is a list of licenses issued.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
