

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

June 15-16, 1971

Members present: James F. Baughman, Vice Chairman, Jim Renshaw and Lon Jarvis
The meeting convened at 10 a.m.

Mr. and Mrs. Phil K. Revell appeared to discuss their application for an outfitter license for hunting on private ground in eastern Idaho. They had a list of signatures with the number of acres owned which they had been granted permission to use. The board suggested that it would be highly desirable to meet with Lee Bridges who is licensed for the public ground in this area and such a meeting will be planned for July. The meeting recessed for lunch until 1:00 p.m.

Dr. Griffith C. Barlow appeared at the request of the board. He confirmed that he does maintain residence in Idaho and is entitled to a resident license. He conceded that he has not used the big game hunting area on the North Fork of the Clearwater and he said he would be willing to release some of it, but he would like to make a trade with Leo Crane or Carl Nagel to give him access to the area known as Devil's Pulpit. He said he would arrange a meeting with Crane and/or Nagel.

Licenses were reviewed until 5:30 p.m. and the meeting recessed until 9:00 a.m. the following morning when it convened with the same members present.

Applications were reviewed.

Phil Swanstrum Conservation Enforcement Division of the Fish & Game Dept., appeared to confirm that conservation officers of his department have been authorized to make an arrest when they run into an outfitter operating without a license. When they find a licensed outfitter operating in another outfitter's area, they will gather information and forward it to the Board.

A contract was signed to approve the loan of a radio to Cecil Sanford by the Fish & Game Dept.

The application of Jack Lykins was reviewed and a report made by Mr. Renshaw on his meeting with Mr. Lykins and Mr. Holman, Moose Creek District Ranger. The attorney for the party complaining against Mr. Lykins had called and said Mr. Lykins had agreed to a settlement and they would withdraw their complaint. Mr. Renshaw made a motion that Mr. Lykins should be placed on probation for a year and his license issued. Seconded and passed.

The addition^{al} area requested by Larry Jarrett on upper Peasley Creek and Silver Creek was approved.

The application of Ray Torrey for a big game hunting area was revised to delete the town of Salmon and an overlap with the area of Randy Capps and the license issued.

New area descriptions were drawn up for Colin Rhoades and Don Nagle.

The application of Steve Jordan for areas surrounding his licensed area was denied because the area is licensed to other outfitters.

The application for a nonresident guide license for Bill Gloeckler was denied as we had been notified by the employing outfitter, Henry Falany, that he would not be working for him in Idaho this year.

The application of Don L. Nitz for the former Nitz Bros. Outfitters, Inc. big game hunting area was approved.

The meeting recessed for dinner until 7:00 p.m. when it reconvened and licenses were issued until 11:30 p.m. The next meeting was set for July 13 and the meeting adjourned.
