

IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD MEETING

Boise Idaho

August 3,4, 1971

Members present: James F. Baughman, Lon Jarvis, R. J. Holmes, and Attorney Kent Taylor.

Mr. Taylor gave the opinion that Ray Torrey should be required to make application for a boat guide license in order to be a float boat guide for H. W. Guth, even though he already has an outfitter license for big game hunting. He cannot qualify for a float boat outfitter and there is also a moratorium on new outfitters operating on the Middle Fork of the Salmon River.

Mr. Taylor also said in his opinion the Board is not bound to divide the big game area of Lyle Phelps as Mr. Phelps and Mrs. Gladys York agreed in their divorce settlement.

The bond submitted by Ted Byers was cancelled by the bonding company. Mr Taylor suggested that we should write him to submit a valid bond within 15 days or we would institute action to revoke his outfitter license.

Roy Strickler submitted his application for the area formerly licensed to Kenneth Strickler and David Oerke submitted an outfitter license application to act as managing agent for Double K Bar Ranchos, Inc. These applications were tentatively approved pending receipt of proper bond and fees.

The meeting recessed for lunch until 1:00 pm.

The letter from Richard Jones was reviewed. If he takes paying passengers on the river he must have a license - in other words, if he makes a training trip, he should not have passengers since he is not licensed.

The Board reviewed other correspondence and recessed at 5:00 pm until 9:00 am August 4, 1971.

The application of John A. Dark was denied for failing to supply information required on the application, pursuant to sections 36-5409c and 36-5413 (1).

The Board discussed with Mr. Hill, of the Fish and Game Department, the new forms for complaints-summons to be used by enforcement officers. We can use the forms of that department.

Recessed for lunch until 1:00 pm.

Dave Giles is to be asked to come to the next meeting to discuss his guides, Horace Marsing, arrested guiding without a guide license; and Mike Tibbetts who has a resident guide license when he may not be a resident of Idaho. The Board also wants to discuss Mr. Giles' application for the Joe Scoble area which is not clearly defined. Martin Capps is to be notified that there may be an overlap in the same area.

Sandy Brooks and Kenneth L. Smith appeared to request that Mr Smith be licensed for Mr. Brooks' area as he wished to discontinue outfitting for big game hunting. This was given tentative approval pending receipt of bond.

It was decided that Louis Rebillet should make application for a guide license for float boating for Mackay Bar Corp., the same as Ray Torrey.

The application of Leo Crane was approved for some area on the North Fork of the Clearwater. The area had been licensed to Dr. Barlow in 1969-70, but he agreed he had not used it.

The Board approved the area exchanges requested by Albert Lamper, Gary Madsen and Gene Nichols by letters of July 12, 1971.

The meeting adjourned at 6:30 pm.
