

IDAHO OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD MEETING

Boise, Idaho

September 9,10, 1971

Members present: James F. Baughman, acting chairman, Jim Renshaw, Lon Jarvis

The meeting convened at 9:00 am.

Mr. John Croner appeared as assistant from the office of the attorney general to furnish legal counsel for the Board.

George Fromm appeared to inquire about getting an outfitter license for the Roy Green area. He was advised to make application and present his qualifications after getting an area release from Mr. Green.

Stanton C. Miller appeared at the request of the Board because he had used an unlicensed guide on the river. Lea Bacos had been arrested and fined \$100.00 for guiding without a license. Mr. Miller stated he thought Mr. Bacas was licensed and that he is no longer working for him.

Lyle Phelps appeared to appeal the denial of his license. His revised application and supporting documents were reviewed. It was decided to give him, for this year, the area bounded by Bargamin Creek, trail 501 and trail 580. Gladys York will be licensed for the remainder of the area.

Martin Capps appeared to apply for the Horse Creek area formerly licensed to Joe Scoble. Dave Giles had been asked to appear relative to his application for this area, but he was not present. The matter was tabled.

Peter Jenkins appeared as attorney for Mr. Ralph Smith, father of Steve Smith who drowned while on a float trip on the Middle Fork of the Salmon River with Dewey Cavin. He asked that Mr. Cavin's outfitter license be revoked.

Mr. Cavin and his attorney, Mr. Lloyd J. Webb, appeared and discussed details of the accident and the fact he did not have a licensed guide in the boat.

Mr. H.W.W. Johnson appeared in answer to an inquiry concerning the beaching of his boat on an island in the Snake River. Mr. Seigmund Rowland was present also, as he was the operator of the boat. He had borrowed the boat and it was not a commercial trip. Mr. Norman Riddle took the passengers off and helped float the boat without a great deal of difficulty

The meeting recessed at 5:45 pm till 9:00 am on September 10, 1971 with the same members present, and Mr. R. J. Holmes and Mr. Croner were also present.

It was the unanimous decision of the Board that there should be a formal hearing for the revocation or suspension of the outfitter license of Mr. Dewey Cavin. Mr. Croner was asked to expedite the matter.

Mr. Ted Williams, Mr. Jim Pepcorn and Mr. Reddæopp appeared to request the transfer of the Williams area to Mr. Pepcorn, who is a teacher in the Burley school. It was suggested that they operate under Mr. Williams license since it is so late in the year and that Mr. Pepcorn apply for a guide license. There are a number of overlaps in the area to be resolved before any transfer is made.

The application of Wick Helmandollar for a guide license to boat for Martin Capps was denied pursuant to 36-5409c for failing to provide information required on the application, 36-5413(1).

The application of Robert Dolph for a guide license was denied. The application had not been signed by a licensed outfitter.

Licenses were issued until 6:30 pm when the meeting recessed until 9:00 am, Saturday September 11, with members Baughman, Holmes and Jarvis present.

Correspondence was reviewed and answered.

The budget for 1972-73 was presented and revised, Mrs Merritt was advised to contact the Personnel Commission regarding a promotion.

Rules and regulations were reviewed, revisions made and approved for public hearing pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act.

The meeting adjourned at 4:30 pm.
