

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

August 31, 1972

The meeting convened at 9:00 am with all members present.

Mr. Paul Kohout appeared to explain the states insurance program with Continental Life Insurance Company. He stated the boards and commission members are insured for \$10,000 and premiums are paid by the respective department.

Motion made by Mr. Renshaw, seconded by Mr. Jarvis that the life insurance premiums be paid for board members from the Outfitters and Guides fund, excepting the permanent member appointed by the Fish and Game Commission. Motion carried.

Mike Wilkins reports were read. He reported that outfitter Eldon Handy instructed his guide not to answer any questions asked by Mr. Wilkins. He also reported that Handy's boats were overloaded and his son, not old enough to qualify for a license, was following in an empty boat.

Mr. Croner appeared and the matter was discussed with him. He advised that the alleged actions would constitute lack of cooperation and resisting an officer in the conduct of his duty. Not reasons for suspending or revoking a licence but could deny a licence in the future if accusations are substantiated.

Mr. Croner reported on his discussions with the attorney for Glenn Schubert regarding denial of his application for outfitting trips on the Middle Fork of the Salmon and his request for a hearing before the board. Time for requesting a hearing according to the statute has run out. Mr. Croner suggested that the board could grant an informal hearing if they so desire. The board concurred in this suggestion to be conveyed to the attorney by Mr. Croner.

It was decided that our investigators should inspect as many camps as possible, concentrating on operations on which we have had complaints and new operators, and any others in the same vicinity.

Jim Kusler appeared to discuss his application for a license in the Priest Lake area. An area for deer hunting was approved with a larger area for bear and cougar.

The meeting recessed for lunch until 1:00 pm.

Mr. Merle Meyers appeared to discuss the possibility of applying for the Garden Creek area formerly licensed to Wilderness Inc.

The big game hunting area for Scott Farr was described and approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Baughman, seconded by Mr. Renshaw, that the board have the centerfold in the Association pamphlet.

Applications for licenses were approved till 6:20 pm when the meeting recessed until 8:30 am on September 1, 1972.

The meeting reconvened with members present--Baughman, Holmes and Renshaw with Mr. Baughman serving as chairman.

Cecil Sanford reported via telephone on his investigations on the Snake River.

Proposed guidelines for board members were read and tabled.

Proposed changes in the law were reviewed and approved for referral to our attorney.

Qualifications for guides were reviewed. It was suggested that outfitter employers be required to certify that an applicant for a guide license is qualified to guide any activities applied for.

Applications for David McFarland and Harold Vinson were denied for power boating and approved for big game hunting, because they did not show qualifying experience for power boating.

Application of Earl Perry was denied because he failed to provide information required of new applicants.

License of Dave, Dick and Dean Helfrich were approved in include big game hunting, bird hunting, and fishing for Everett Spaulding.

Mr. May's license was extended to include bird hunting.

The meeting adjourned at 4:00 pm.
