

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho  
October 2, 1972

The meeting convened at 9:00 a.m. with members present: James F. Baughman, Vice Chairman; Lon Jarvis; and R. J. Holmes.

John L. Booker appeared to discuss his application for a big game outfitter license for the area formerly licensed to Wilderness, Inc. and which he operated for the corporation in 1970. He stated that Wilderness, Inc. is in the process of dissolving and he has purchased the outfitting equipment.

Chairman Rex Lanham arrived.

Merle Meyers had also made application for a license for the area and was expected to appear later in the day. Mr. Booker was told he could call later in the day for the decision of the board.

Joe Scoble called in regard to his late application for an outfitter license as he was unable to appear as requested. He stated that the bear and cougar shown in his report for 1971 were killed on his ranch and that is where he intends to hunt this year.

License applications were reviewed. The application of Randy Blood for a guide license was denied pursuant to 36-5409c and 36-5413-6 for conviction of a fish and game law violation in 1971--killing a deer in closed season by spotlight.

Meeting recessed for lunch until 1:00 p.m.

Robert J. Sevy appeared to discuss his application for a boating outfitter license and was given tentative approval pending completion of the application as per instructions.

Proposed changes for the Outfitters and Guides Act were discussed.

Carlos Taylor appeared to find out if Ray J. Taylor could have his outfitter license extended to include power boating on the Snake River. He would have to employ a qualified guide as he has not had sufficient experience to be a power boat guide.

Since Mr. Merle Meyers did not appear, the board concluded from available information that Mr. Booker is more qualified through experience as an outfitter and knowledge of the area and his application was approved.

The denial of the application of Jack Gillihan for a guide license was confirmed, pursuant to Idaho Code 36-5409c and 36-5413-7, conviction of a game law violation.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:50 p.m.
