

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

June 25-26, 1973

The meeting convened at 8:30 a.m. with members Baughman, Renshaw, and Jarvis.

Tom Hansen appeared to discuss his application for the big game hunting area formerly licensed to Dr. Bacon. He was told that his application could not be approved unless he had a base of operation.

Dan Robertson appeared and presented an application for an outfitter license for his father, Jay Robertson, for hunting bear and cougar. The conservation officer in the area was consulted. His recommendation was to allow one more outfitter in the area along with the two already there. The application was approved.

The meeting recessed from 12 to 1 o'clock.

John A. Dark appeared in connection with his application to take over the outfitter operation of Harold Smith at Meadow Creek. Approved.

Chairman Rex Lanham appeared.

A discussion regarding areas for summer outfitting activities was had. Recent changes in our law make it mandatory that we have more specific information on what each outfitter is doing and where. Lon Jarvis made a motion that we send a questionnaire to each outfitter to obtain information on summer activities. Second, Renshaw. Motion carried.

Bob Cole appeared to request that he be allowed to take fishermen in the Stanley area, no boating. Approved.

Applications were reviewed until 5:45 p.m. when the meeting recessed until 8:30 a.m. with all members present.

Byron Holcomb and Carl Hagaman appeared to discuss the transfer of Mr. Holcomb's area to Mr. Hagaman. Mr. Holcomb would like to take care of the clients he has booked for this fall and Mr. Hagaman would assist him as a guide. Since Mr. Hagaman appeared to be a qualified outfitter, the board suggested that he complete an application.

Mr. Harry Lewies appeared to ask that his outfitter license be extended to allow him to take fishermen in the vicinity of Warm River Inn, Mesa Falls to Ashton. Approved.

The meeting recessed from 12 to 1 o'clock.

Tom Hansen appeared again to inform the board that he had arranged to lease a ranch that had been previously<sup>used</sup> as a base of operation for outfitting in the Panther Creek area.

Wayne Crookston appeared, accompanied by Bill White and his attorney,

Ellison Matthews. Mr. White desires to make application for an outfitter license for Indian Lake Outfitters, Inc. with himself as manager in place of Richard Higgins whose application for license has been denied by the board. He said that after the coming season it is his intention to buy out Mr. Higgins' interest in the business, that he has purchased all new equipment, and that he would be in charge of the Idaho operation. He was advised to submit his application providing he can get campsite permits from the Forest Service.

Lon Jarvis made a motion that the chairmanship of the board revolve each year at the April meeting. Second Renshaw. Discussion. Mr. Jarvis withdrew his motion with the consent of Mr. Renshaw.

Applications were reviewed.

The application of Gene Nichols was denied pursuant to Idaho Code 36-5409c for the reason set forth in Chapter 54 Section 13-7, for a substantial breach of a contract. Mr. Renshaw asked to be excused from voting on this matter.

Joe Tonsmeire was denied float boating on Henry's Fork from Osburne bridge to Sheep Falls for a 2-day trip.


Max Bitton's letter requesting the Redfish Lake Creek drainage was reviewed. We have no knowledge that Mr. McMaster is planning to give it up. Will hold the letter on file, but the area for trail rides would not be exclusive.

Roy Nicholson was denied boating on the Upper Salmon and Upper Snake as we have nothing to show that he has operated previously in either location and new licenses are not being issued.

Rudy Edelberg was denied float boating on the Salmon River, Ralph Pond, the Main Salmon and Selway, David Thompson, the Main Salmon, and Sam Slavin denied boating on any classified river, all because they lacked the required experience. R. Steve King was denied guiding on the Payette as it is not a commercial float river and his outfitter employer is not licensed for this river.

Licenses issued after approval via telephone, since the last meeting, were reaffirmed and are included in the attached list.
