

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

April 15-19, 1974

Members present: Chairman Rex Lanham, James Baughman, and Lon Jarvis. The purpose of the meeting was for the review of applications for license.

The meeting was called to order at 9 o'clock and the minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved unanimously.

Jim Moorhead and Frank Elder appeared to discuss problems on the Salmon River and the Salmon National Forest. Float permits will be required on the Salmon River. They will be granted to outfitters who have been running the Salmon during the last two years according to Forest Service records. Any others will have to establish a history of use before they will be issued campsite permits.

The Forest Service wants to limit outfitter use in the Bighorn Crags, particularly for horse travel.

The meeting recessed for lunch.

Jim Campbell appeared to request the area across the river from Shepp Ranch. The board agreed that he should go to the top of the breaks.

Curtis Prock appeared to submit an application for an outfitter license. Ray Ralls has already applied for the Prock area and if Mr. Ralls' application is approved, Mr. Prock would like his application denied.

Applications were reviewed until 5 p.m. when the meeting recessed until 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, April 16, with members present, Lanham, Baughman, Jarvis and Holmes. Applications were reviewed until 5 p.m. with a recess at noon.

The meeting reconvened at 8:30 a.m. on April 17, with Baughman, Jarvis, Renshaw and Holmes present. Applications were reviewed until 5 p.m. with a recess for lunch. Mr. Lanham was present for the afternoon session.

The meeting reconvened at 8:30 a.m. on April 18, with Baughman, Jarvis and Renshaw present. Applications were reviewed.

Dick Mott, Reynold Hensley, and Ross McLaughlin appeared to inform the board that they had purchased a controlling interest in Idaho Vacations, Inc. from Steve Jordan, and they were inquiring about the status of the license. Mr. Jordan is no longer manager of the James Ranch. The outfitter license has been in Jordan's name instead of the corporation name for the past two years and the application for next year is the same. The board told them they would have to show

cause why Mr. Jordan's application should not be approved.

The meeting recessed at 5 p.m. until 9 a.m. on Friday, April 19, with Lanham, Baughman, and Jarvis present.

Plans were made for the May meeting in Salmon. All remaining completed applications for outfitter licenses were reviewed.

It appeared that almost all outfitters conducting trailrides also asked for mountain climbing, a new category on the application forms this year for technical mountaineering and rock climbing. Since they did not send in their qualifications for this, it was apparent that the type of activity was misunderstood. It was decided to send a form letter denying mountain climbing and cross country skiing until the board has evidence of qualifications and experience for these activities.

Applications were reviewed. A list of activities and/or licenses denied and a list of licenses approved is attached hereto.

The meeting adjourned at 5 p.m.

- Allison Ranch & Harold E. Thomas; denied float boating on M. Fk., Main Salmon and Owyhee River for lack of experience and the moratorium.
- Berry, Randy; big game hunting denied as the area is licensed to Kunz and Robson
- Fremont Outdoor Education & Rec., Inc. & P. Blain Hawkes denied trailrides and backpacking as no equipment was shown, no experience or specific area requested.
- Giles, Dave; denied Bighorn Crags and Pine Creek drainage - other outfitters prev. licensed
- Haderlie, Vaughn; power and float boating on S. Fk. Snake and Swan Valley-Palisades Creek for trailrides - used by public for fishing and other outfitters have Swan Valley
- Harvey, Floyd; boating from Riggins to White Bird and all float boating as 10' raft inadequate for classified rivers.
- Helfrich, Dave; power boating on Salmon R. from White Bird to mouth and Snake R. to Lewiston denied-no previous use and there are adequate number of outfitters to serve public.
- Farr, Scott; upper Salmon R. - used by public for fishing
- Idaho Adventures & Henry V. Miller; S. Fk Snake and cross county skiing - S.Fk used by public
- Kovalik, Vladimir; Bruneau and Owyhee Rivers - no experience shown
- Leonard, Joe; kayaking on Yankee Fk. - not suitable for commercial use.
- Miller, Stanton C.; trailrides in Bighorn Crags and Chamberlain Basin - others with prior use history; South Fork Salmon, Bruneau and power boating on Snake from mouth of Salmon to Lewiston - no experience shown; Bear & cougar hunting - no area.
- Moose Creek Ranch Co. & Dave Christensen; trailrides in Selway, Bitterroot Wilderness Area not specific; power boating from French Creek to Riggins during steelhead season.
- Ney, Dale; Upper Salmon - no previous operation; Lead Boatman on Selway - experience; trailrides to Bighorn Crags, Waterfall, and Garden Creek areas used by other outfitters; Yellow Jacket area allowed ~~by~~ not via the Crags.
- Norrick, Mel; Lead Boatman on Owyhee - experience
- Oakes, Hollis; float boating on the Salmon & Snake River - no experience shown
- Ralls, Ray; West side of 95 - area revised
- Rhett, Homer; Selway and Salmon R. from French Cr. to Snake - not lic. previously
- Robinson, Wayne; Leader area for big game hunting (substituted area in Targhee); Snake R. & tributaries for fishing - too inclusive
- Smith, Robert M.; from Locksa to Moose Cr. for bear and cougar as others have been in area
