

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Salmon, Idaho

May 1, 1974

The meeting convened at 9 a.m. at the Stagecoach Motel with members present Rex Lanham, Chairman, James F. Baughman, Lon Jarvis and R. J. Holmes.

Steve Jordan appeared to discuss refusal of campsite permits on the Salmon River by the Forest Service. He was asked how he intends to operate if all his equipment now belongs to Idaho Vacations, Inc. He said he would have two 24' boats available by the time the season starts. He is looking into several places available for a base of operation.

Jack Nancolas, Dave Giles and Ken Smith appeared. Nancolas would relinquish all rights to big game hunting area to Giles and Smith if board approves. The board approved since they are already licensed for most of the area, jointly with Nancolas.

Mr. & Mrs. Herbert Wagoner appeared to discuss application for license for the same area licensed to hunt in 1972-73. He said he would submit an application.

Mr. & Mrs. Gene Nichols and Richard Banning appeared to discuss the joint use areas on the licenses of Gene Nichols and Ben Smith for 1973-74. Ben Smith has sold his operation to Flying R Outfitters, Inc. Mr. Nichols has asked that the joint use of Trout Creek be deleted from their license. Several solutions were suggested and the matter was tabled until the district ranger could be consulted.

The meeting recessed for lunch.

Al Tice appeared to request that, if there is a change in outfitter at the James Ranch, their boundary with Mackay Bar be moved west to Warren Creek from Mann Creek Ridge.

Gene Nichols appeared again to offer to relinquish the drainage of Magpie Creek on the west side of the Selway, to Flying R Outfitters, Inc. if they are not licensed for Trout Creek. The board agreed to consider that alternative along with other proposals.


Loyal Willis appeared and presented a letter asking for elimination of joint use Flying Resort Ranches, Inc. areas with Rick Hussey and Rosalie Horner. The board agreed to look into the matter.

Herbert Carls and Chuck Overland appeared to discuss taking over the operation of Rosalie Horner. They will complete their application. They said they had no objection to relinquishing the Soldier Creek area to Flying Resort Ranches, Inc. However, they did not want to give up the early hunt rights in Cow Basin.

Applications were reviewed. A list of activities and/or licenses denied and a list of licenses approved is attached hereto.

The board will meet informally with Forest Service representatives on Thurs., May 2, at 9 a.m. at the Salmon National Forest headquarters and will attend meetings of the Outfitters and Guides Association on May 3 & 4.

The meeting adjourned at 5:40 p.m.
