

## OUTFITTERS & GUIDES BOARD MEETING

Boise, Idaho

November 18-19, 1974

The meeting was called for the purpose of holding formal hearings and to take care of any other business which might come before it.

Members present were James F. Baughman, vice chairman, R. J. Holmes, and Lon S. Jarvis.

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Vice Chairman Baughman.

Dave Lee, Tom Kovalicky, Jim Hand, and Jerry Green from the Sawtooth NRA appeared to discuss requirements for cross country ski outfitters, operating on public land. An Intermountain Division of the U. S. Ski Association has been established to conduct a certification program for cross country ski instructors in Idaho and adjoining states. It was decided to ask the skiers to meet with the board at McCall in December.

Complaints against Clifford L. Ferguson were reviewed until the meeting recessed for lunch.

The meeting reconvened at 1 p.m. and recessed at 1:30 p. m. for the hearing in case No. 74-012, in the Matter of Clifford L. Ferguson, Revocation of License pursuant to notice duly given.

The regular meeting of the board reconvened at 3 p.m. with the same members present.

Mr. Holmes moved that the outfitter license of Clifford L. Ferguson, No. 207 be revoked. Seconded by Jarvis. The motion was un-animously approved.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

Applications were reviewed.

The fee submitted by Robert Sterner to guide for Cliff Ferguson is to be returned to him. He already has a current guide license and does not need another to guide for a different outfitter. Licenses approved by telephone since the meeting of September 19, were re-affirmed and are included in the list of licenses as part of these minutes.

The meeting recessed at 5 p.m. until 8:30 a. m. on November 19, when it reconvened with the members present James F. Baughman, R. J. Holmes and Lon S. Jarvis.

The file of Joseph H. Adams was reviewed. Wayne Crookston appeared to advise the board.

The meeting recessed at 10 a. m. for a hearing to determine the qualifications of Joe H. Adams to hold an outfitter license.

The meeting reconvened at 2:30 p. m. with the same members present.

Mr. Holmes made a motion that the outfitter license application of Joe H. Adams be denied pursuant to Idaho Code 5409 (b) 1 & 2 and 36-5409c for the reason set forth in 36-5413-1. Seconded by Jarvis and unanimously approved. This action was taken pursuant to Idaho Code 5409 (b) 1 & 2: ...In so approving and/or licensing any outfitter's or guide's activity, the board shall consider the following, among others: (1) the length of time in which the applicant has operated in that area; (2) The extent to which the applicant is qualified by reason of experience, equipment or resources to operate in that area.

Also, pursuant to Idaho Code 36-5409c for the reason set forth in Idaho Code, 36-5413-1: ... for failure to provide information required to be furnished by the license application form for a license currently valid.

John Jones and Wayne Beuke appeared in reference to an application to float the Salmon River from Corn Creek to the mouth and the Snake River from Hells Canyon Dam to Lewiston, Suggestions were given to complete the application.

Plans were made to meet with the Forest Service at McCall on December 3, and with cross country skiers on the 4th.

William Hon and Mr. & Mrs. Joe Leonard appeared to request additional area on Cherry Creek for cross country skiing. They were asked to submit the request in writing.

Correspondence was reviewed. The application and fee for a guide license was returned to Floyd Held at his request. He intends to conduct an outfitting operation.

A letter from Frederick T. Cushing was read, asking for the board to reconsider the denial of his application for a guide license because of a fish and game law violation. A motion was made by Jarvis to stand by previous decision to deny the application. Seconded by Holmes and unanimously approved.

The meeting adjourned at 6 p. m. until December 3, at Shore Lodge, McCall.
