

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD MEETING

Boise, Idaho

April 21,22,23, 1975

Members present were Chairman Lanham, and Lon Jarvis. James F. Baughman was ill and Jim Renshaw and R. J. Holmes unable to be present. Since there was not a quorum the morning was spent reviewing applications and issuing licenses to those previously approved by a third member. The meeting recessed at noon until 9 a.m. on April 22 with Lanham, Jarvis and Holmes present.

Bob Cole and Joseph P. Gouvea appeared to ask for the transfer of Middle Fork Lodge's Cache Creek area to Mr. Gouvea who had been their guide in the area for several years. He had obtained a lease on the Fish and Game Department ranch and would operate from there. The transfer was tentatively approved pending completion of the application, *with the understanding that there will be no further transfer of this area.*

Harry Lewies appeared to request boating on Henry's Fork and Teton in order to conduct a fly fishing school for the Orvis Company. He also requested fishing on the smaller streams in the area. The board took the matter under consideration and will make a decision after hearing from others in that area.

Norman Rudolph came in to discuss a license for trailrides in the Owyhees. The board saw no problem.

Will Godfrey came in to urge the board not to license additional outfitters on Henry's Fork. He suggested there be a limit to the number of guides an outfitter could have out in impacted areas or outfitters could be required to stay in certain segments of the river. He said during June last year there would be 37 guides on Henry's Fork during any one day.

Randy Berry came in to protest the licensing of more outfitters on the Teton and Henry's Fork. Said his clients catch and release.

The meeting recessed at noon and the members met with Governor Andrus after lunch, reconvening at 2:45.

Hank Miller came in to ask for boating from White Bird to Lewiston. Approved.

Dave Stucker came in to discuss his application for the Louis Rebillet area. Approved.

The meeting recessed at 4:30 p.m. until 9:30 a.m. April 23, with same members present.

Mr. Holmes made a motion that all board correspondence be signed "Outfitters and Guides Board, R. E. Lanham, Chairman, by whoever signs the letter." Seconded by Jarvis. Motion carried.

Applications were reviewed until noon when the meeting recessed until 1 p.m. Correspondence was reviewed. Gene Nichols' letter to his clients stating he had taken in a partner was criticised as not factual and not meeting the requirements of Rule No. 14 and he is to
