

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD MEETING

Boise, Idaho

June 18-20, 1975

The meeting convened at 8:30 a.m. with members present: Vice Chairman James F. Baughman, R. J. Holmes and Lon S. Jarvis. The members went in a body to the meeting room of the Fish and Game Department for a public hearing for the adoption of changes and additions to substantive rules and regulations of the Outfitters and Guides Board. The meeting reconvened at the board office at 1 p.m. with the same members present and Jim Renshaw.

Applications were reviewed.

Chris Cieslek came before the board to request an outfitter license. She had been a partner in setting up Walt Mason's outfitting business. She said he had sold most of the equipment and did not appear to be planning to operate this year. He has not applied for a license. She said she has two good men lined up to handle the guiding. She was advised that the board could make no committment without all the information required on the application form and information on the qualification of the guides.

Dale Robson's protest of the late fee charged him was reviewed. Renshaw made a motion that the late fee be waived due to the fact that he said it was mailed on March 31, and it may have been taken to a central post office before it was postmarked. Second, Holmes. Motion carried.

A discussion was had on moving the office since we have had notice to vacate our present location by July 5. Plans were made to investigate some possibilities suggested by the secretary.

The meeting recessed at 4:30 p.m. to look at near by office space, till 8:30 a.m. on June 19, with the same members present. There was further discussion on office locations.

The meeting recessed at 9:15 a.m. to go to the Fish and Game building for a public hearing to amend procedural rules for the Outfitters and Guides Board. Reconvened at 10:30 a. m.

Mr. Jarvis presented a resolution that we gather information on a number of people using the various rivers and river segments for the purpose of determining the number of parties and number of people for each outfitter, since merely limiting the number of outfitters will not solve the problem of overcrowding the resource.

Jim Campbell came in to request the Jarbidge, Bruneau and Owyhee River. He was licensed previously but neglected to put it on his application last year and this year they were denied. He reapplied for big game hunting for Rick Petrillo and James C. Conley for Wilderness Ranches, Inc. Approved.

Minutes of previous meetings were read and a correction noted on the license for Joseph P. Gouvea. Motion to approve made by Holmes, second by Renshaw and approved unanimously.

A discussion was had on settling claims against Ferguson's bond. It was decided to send a certified letter to those who did not sign and return the affidavit giving the board authority to pro rate their claims.

The meeting recessed at 5:15 till 8:30 a.m. on June 20, with same members present.

The application of Grand Canyon Dorries, Inc. and Curtis Chang, managing agent, were reviewed. Their brochure is advertising Idaho trips, printed before an application was submitted. They are already running the Snake River without a license. A letter from the Fish and Game Department to Mr. Litton, president of Grand Canyon Dorries, Inc. tells of having to retrieve department equipment taken from their Granite Creek camp and stored aboard Grand Canyon Dorries, Inc. boats. Applications denied misleading advertising and operating in an area where not licensed. Pursuant to Idaho Code 36-5409C for reasons given in 36-5413-2 & 8.

James Hadley, Director of Oregon State Marine Board and his assistant, Webb Terwillegar came in to discuss our regulations for licensing boaters on rivers. Oregon has just started controls last year, will meet with their guides this fall and update their rules and regulations. They have studied the capacity of Oregon's wild rivers and will send us a report when it is completed about July.

Loyal Willis came in to request that the joint use of Cow Basin and lower Soldier Creek be removed from adjacent outfitter licenses. In exchange Flying Resort Ranch will give up their South Fork Rush Creek area. He says that Rich Hussey has never used the Soldier Creek area. The board agreed to investigate the matter.

Mr. & Mrs. Elvin Hincks and son, Tony, appeared to answer to complaints received--One a spot pack and another from a party who asked for a refund of deposits when the season was changed from six days to three days. The board explained that while it was not his fault he couldn't give them a six day hunt, neither was it theirs. Since he was unable to hunt them as agreed, the board recommended that Mr. Hincks return their deposits. Mr. Hincks agreed that he would do so. It appeared that one of the hunters on the spot pack expected more service than is ordinarily provided with a spot pack.

Mr. Hincks asked that no outfitter be licensed for the East Fork Palisades Creek if Glen Park does not use it.

Lee Bridges appeared to discuss complaints from his hunters. Said his biggest problem was lack of stock for his hunters in opening week. He would like to sell his outfit to a Montana outfitter, Don Habel of Corvallis.

Mr. Habel came in and submitted an application which the board reviewed. He had already been recommended by the district ranger where he had operated in Montana for twelve years. The application was approved.

James Sweener came in to discuss his purchase of the Dwayne Whipple area on Crooked Creek. He said he hunted the area last fall with Whipple and has outfitted in Arizona several years. Application approved after reviewing references.

Dave Helfrich came in to request additional boating, i.e. the Jarbidge where they launch Bruneau trips and power boating from Spring Bar to Lewiston. approved.
