

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD MEETING

Boise, Idaho

November 18, 19, 1975

The meeting convened at 9 a. m. with all members present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read. Mr. Jarvis made a motion they be approved, seconded by Renshaw and unanimously approved.

Under old business there was a discussion on turning the proceeds of Ferguson's bond over to the bankruptcy trustee. A request for the money from Larry Larkin, the trustee, was read and it was noted that he did not ask for claims against the bond nor indicate that it would be reserved for people who made deposits on hunts. It was decided to write him for a statement of his intentions in this matter.

Proposed law changes were reviewed and approved to be forwarded to the attorney general for approval and putting into bill form for presentation to the legislature.

Licenses were approved for Michael R. Bishop, Tom F. Edmondson, Stanley P. Glover, Gina S. Gray and Nick Robinson. A list of licenses approved, extended and denied since the August meeting is attached.

Incomplete applications were reviewed. Most of them are for guide licenses which were returned for completion or letters written for further information on qualifications. The board decided to follow up on these through the employing outfitters. Two applications, for Steven D. White and Kenneth C. Van Bergen, were signed by Gordon Stimmel. He is to be invited to meet with the board at McCall. Echo, the Wilderness Co. also has three incomplete applications for boat guides. They will need to appear before the board, also.

The board voted to have a one page ad in the association pamphlet.

Complaints were reviewed. It was voted to send all information about St. Joe Outfitters to our attorney for advice on what course to take.

Bruce Baird appeared to discuss an outfitter license primarily for bear and cougar hunting in southeastern Idaho. He was advised to complete his application.

Tom Hansen appeared to apply for the Bighorn Crags area formerly licensed to Robert Merrick. He said there is little game in the area and the only access is through his area. Anyone trying to hunt it creates problems with his hunters. He was told to make application for it so that it will be on file. Since Merrick has appealed the denial of his license, the board is not in a position to make the change at this time.

The complaint against John Vail was reviewed. He is to be contacted by letter regarding the charges.

The meeting recessed at 5:15 p. m.

The meeting reconvened at 8:30 a. m. on November 19, with members present Vice Chairman Baughman, Renshaw and Holmes.

Correspondence received since the last meeting was reviewed.

A complaint against Joe Peck was reviewed. A hunter charged that the

Water supply was contaminated by the livestock. We will check this with the Forest Service and talk to Joe Peck at the McCall meeting.

Gary Madsen's request for additional area was reviewed. The area requested for bow hunting is already licensed to Ray Torrey and Dare Anderson. A letter from Mike Loening asked the board's approval for the sale of his big game hunting operation to Gary Madsen. Tentative approval was given pending receipt of application from Madsen.

A complaint against Travis York was reviewed. The board would like to have names and addresses of other members of the party in order to contact them for further information. A complaint against Al Beam was reviewed. He is to be asked to appear before the board at the first meeting in 1976.

A question arose concerning commercial float boating on the North Fork and Middle Fork of the Clearwater River. The Clearwater River named as a classified river refers to the segment from Kooskia to Lewiston. Opinions on the matter are to be sought from fish and game department personnel and Lewiston area sportsmen.

A test for applicants for new outfitters was discussed. The staff was directed to work on this.

A request for a table, bookcase and hardboard carpet covers was reviewed. Renshaw offered a motion that their purchase be authorized, seconded by Holmes and passed unanimously.

The next meeting will be December 2 and 3, at Shore Lodge, McCall. The January meeting is set for the 7th at Boise.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 4 p. m.
