

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

June 2-3, 1976

The meeting convened at 9 a.m. with members present: Vice-Chairman Baughman, R. J. Holmes, Lon S. Jarvis, and William R. Guth.

The minutes of the meeting of April 9, 12, & 13 were read and a motion made by Holmes, seconded by Jarvis, to accept the minutes as read.

The minutes of April 26 & 27 were read. A motion was made by Guth, seconded by Holmes, that everything after the departure of Mr. Jarvis at 4:45 p.m. be stricken from the minutes because the meeting adjourned at that time. The motion was unanimously approved.

A motion was made by Guth, seconded by Holmes, that the board accept payment of the outfitter license bond of Clifford L. Ferguson who filed for bankruptcy in late 1974, and proceed with the distribution on a pro-rata basis as advised by our attorney, Jordan Smith, the motion was unanimously approved. Baughman and Guth were designated a committee to research these verified claims and present them to the board.

The application of Nez Perce Outfitters and Guides and Val Johnson, managing agent, were reviewed. A letter from Dean Byrne, West Fork District Ranger stated he would not be given a permit for trailrides in the area requested around Magruder and head of Selway. The applications were approved for boating on the Middle Fork but denied for trailrides until a suitable location is found.

Ken Carpenter's revised application was approved for float boating from Spring Bar to Lewiston.

Joe Leonard's application was approved, except for rock climbing. This was denied because he showed no experience. He was approved as a boatman on the Middle Fork when employed by an outfitter licensed for that river.

Halfway House, Inc. and Bruce LaFavour, managing agent, were approved for activities and areas as revised when Mr. LaFavour appeared before the board on April 27.

Guide applications were reviewed.

The application of Harold Speltz was denied. Big game hunting was denied, based upon (1) Idaho Code 36-5409 (b-4) because the many roads in the area make it accessible to the general public. (2) Idaho Code 36-5409 (b-5) because we have evidence on file that the controlled hunt areas applied for are not adequate for a commercial big game hunting area. All other activities were denied because he had stated during his meeting with the board on April 26, and repeated in a letter of May 24, that he would not be interested in a license which did not include big game hunting. Further it was noted that his bond was a photocopy and not properly executed.

There was a discussion on the job openings for the office staff. The matter was tabled and the meeting recessed at 5 p.m. until 8 a.m. following morning, June 3, with the same members present.

Openings on rivers was discussed. It was found that there is an opening for power boating on the Salmon River from Spring Bar to the mouth. Dick Merrill is first on our priority list for this and he is to be notified that he should submit a request if he is still interested in this.

Chairman Lanham arrived. George May and Charles Willmore came before the board in an effort to establish a more satisfactory boundary line between their big game hunting areas. The boundaries were not changed but it is hoped that there is a better under-

standing of where the line is located since in some places it does not follow a natural boundary such as a trail or ridge.

The meeting recessed to meet with Ms. Matlock of the personnel commission regarding job classifications.

The meeting reconvened at 1:30 p.m. with members present: Lanham, Baughman, Holmes, and Guth.

Tom Slyter appeared to request a license for hunting big game, primarily bear, in an area on the west side of the North Fork Payette River. He was advised that the area is open for commercial bear hunting but not big game hunting. He revised his application to include bear, cougar and predators, only. His application was not complete so no further action was taken.

Applications were reviewed.

O.A.R.S. is to be notified by certified mail that their application should be completed without delay as we cannot hold an opening on the river when there is not a complete application.

The board asked Mrs. Bobbitt if she would accept the position of administrative secretary. She said she would accept it at a salary from \$700 to \$750 per month but she thought that \$750 would be more in line with the responsibility and work required. Mr. Baughman was designated to see if this could be arranged.

The meeting adjourned at 6 p.m.
