

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

September 7-8, 1976

Jim Baughman arrived at 8:45 a.m.

Mr. & Mrs. Fred Wright of Victor, Montana arrived for their appointment with the board at 9:30 a.m.

At 10:15 a.m. Rex Lanham and Bill Guth arrived. The board discussed Mr. Wright taking over Don Jackman's area at the end of this year's hunting season. He will be running Jerry Spear's operation this year. The board did not object to this area being licensed to Mr. Wright when a late fee, outfitter bond, and the approval of the forest service ranger has been received. We have received a letter from Mr. Jackman stating he will not be able to continue his operation because of his wife's health.

Guide licenses for Steven T. Dalton, William L. Eakland, Tim O'Niell and Thomas Rambo for Grand Canyon Dories, outfitter, were denied pursuant to Idaho Code 36-5404 and 36-5413 (14), and for operating on a portion of the Salmon River where their employing outfitter was not licensed.

The secretary was instructed to write Idaho Vacations, Inc. about Chuck Cairns statement on his application that he had worked for Idaho Vacations, Inc. last year, but was not licensed.

The board reviewed Gary Madsen's letter requesting additional area for bow hunting. The area was approved for a temporary license this year due to insufficient time to review the area. He can re-apply next year if he wants it.

Gary Merritt's trip into the White Cloud area was discussed. Bill Guth volunteered to ask the licensed outfitters in that area if they had been contacted about the trip.

The board discussed the complaint against Dale Ney.

The minutes of the last board meeting were read and approved as read.

Recessed for lunch at 12:00.

The meeting reconvened at 1:15 p.m. with the same members present.

A letter from Ken Moyer of College Park, Maryland inquiring about Gladys York and Dean Manes. The secretary was instructed to tell him that York was not licensed and the other two outfitters he wrote about have good reputations as outfitters.

Sergei Paul Lagodich's resident guide application was denied as the board determined from the information obtained, he was not a resident when the application was submitted.

Outfitter license applications for Hidden Valley Ranches, Dave Oerke, M.A., M & M Outfitters and Mike Bishop, M.A. were approved.

The complaint from Pete Mathews about John Jones was discussed. Bill Guth made a motion "on December 6 or 7 to have an informal hearing with both parties about the complaint". Jim Baughman seconded the motion and it was unanimously passed.

The board instructed the secretary to write a certified letter to Dale Ney asking him to appear at the December meeting for a hearing on his complaint, as he did not appear or call about his appointment today.

The board declined to act on David Engerbretson's guide application as it was incomplete.

The legislative auditor's report was read by the board.

The board discussed inviting a representative from each forest district in Idaho to meet with them on December 7, before the Association meeting.

A letter from Roland M. Stoleson, District Ranger of Slate Creek Ranger Station in White Bird was read concerning a permit violation in the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest by Forrest Garrigus. The secretary was instructed to write the Pine Creek Ranger District in Halfway, Oregon about his other violations they mention in the letter.

The board discussed the telephone call from a Mr. Duckworth of Lewiston asking the board to allow him to go up the Salmon River "just one mile" without a license--no action was taken.

The Fish and Game Department has asked the board to meet with them this fall. The board decided, if possible, all of the board should be there, and if Lon Jarvis and Rocky Holmes could attend a meeting on October 21 or 22 when the Fish and Game were having their meeting, they would try to set up a meeting at that time.

Harold Speltz's lawyer postponed Speltz's hearing on September 8. The hearing will be held on November 8 or 9th.

The board recessed at 5 p.m.

September 8

Board members present were Jim Baughman and Bill Guth. As a quorum was not present on decisions could be made.

They discussed the priority application received from John L. Hill, Jr. for the Henry's Fork and the South Fork of the Snake River.

A complaint from William Rine of Boise about a moose hunt in Glenn Parks' area also was discussed. Parks did not take any pay and did not guide Mr. Rine, just told him where to hunt.

Guy Hurlbutt of the attorney general's office came with a proposal from Speltz's lawyer on the outfitter application. As a quorum was not present, they set November 8 to decide on the application.

Grand Canyon Dorries citations were discussed.

George Slyter came in to discuss his proposed outfitter license application for bear and cougar hunting. The two board members told him they could see no problem when he completes his application.

Steve Jordan appeared to discuss Jim Powell's guide license application and was told to get affidavits from Paul Filer and Al Tice on his qualifications.

The meeting recessed for lunch, at 1:15 p.m. the meeting reconvened.

There was discussion on the Thevinin trip OK from Falany, subpoenas for the records of Paul Schild and Harold Thomas, Ken Carpenter's corrected brochure, Bob Eaton's call on his area, and calls on George May.

A list of outfitters and guides who were approved, denied, amended or extended since the last meeting is attached and part of these minutes.

Meeting adjourned at 2:30 p.m.
