

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

April 18, 19, 20, 1977

The Outfitters and Guides Board met on April 18, at 9:00 at the Boise office with Rex Lanham, Chairman, James Baughman, Vice-Chairman, Bill Guth and Lon Jarvis present. Guy Hurlbutt, our attorney from the Attorney General's office was also present.

Mr. Hurlbutt notified the board that the court hearing with Grand Canyon Dorries would be May 2nd, about out of state license fees and guides. All information in the Grand Canyon Dorries file was reviewed, also the guides files were reviewed and discussed.

J. C. Marshall met with the board to discuss his proposed big game outfitter activities. He plans a seven day hunt for \$1500.00. He said he would have a one-week trip with paying guests and one-week with friends. He is a realator at Cataldo.

Carl Estep and Wayne Brenner of Edah-How Kennels from Weiser talked to the board about an outfitter license for bird hunting and fishing. The board advised them they could only be licensed on public property and to send in a complete application for the board to review.

The board discussed the proposed regulation 8 (1-i) on the length of time a big game outfitter had prior to opening of hunting season to submit a complete application. It was decided to leave it in and have it discussed at the hearing.

The board recessed for lunch and reconvened at 1:00 with the same members present.

Duane Beale and Gordon Stimmel met with the board to discuss dividing Gordon Stimmel's big game hunting area. He will release all of his area east of 4th of July Creek to Mr. Beale. The board reviewed Mr. Beale's outfitter application and could find no problems with the proposal.

The board continued discussing the proposed rules and regulations and made some changes suggested at the association meeting in McCall.

Eldon Handy arrived to discuss the proposed rules and regulations with the board. He offered to send the proposed rules and regulations to all of the boating outfitters in the association.

The board recessed at 5:15.

Tuesday, April 19, at 9:00 the following board members reconvened the meeting: James Baughman, Vice-Chairman, Bill Guth and Lon Jarvis.

The board called Cal Stoddard on the telephone and talked to him about Wilmore's area.

The guide licenses for Grand Canyon Dorries are to be put in the incomplete file as Grand Canyon Dorries does not have an outfitter license.

A letter from National Outdoor Leadership School of Lander, Wyoming, was read requesting a hearing with the board on the board's decision that they are outfitters. They are to be given an appointment at the next meeting.

The State Insurance Fund statement for unemployment compensation was discussed.

A letter from Frank H. Comiskey asking for the name of George May's bonding company and the number of the bond as he paid George May \$4,000.00 for a hunt, then cancelled the hunt and asked George May for a refund, but has not received anything. The secretary will answer the letter giving the bond number and company and tell him that

to this date that Mr. May has not applied for an outfitter license.

A letter from Daniel E. Supple was read requesting a hearing on his outfitter license denial. He is to be written and given an appointment at the next meeting.

A copy of a letter from Samuel Ford was received from Fish and Game Department asking about licensing requirements if he flies customers into the back country for fishing. The secretary was instructed to tell him that if he furnished only transportation and did nothing else he would not need a license.

A letter from R. M. Grenwell with a complaint against Chuck Overland was read. The secretary was instructed to write him that it is usually the policy of the board to call the outfitter into the office to discuss complaints and we hope he has a good hunting trip with Scott Farr this next year.

A letter from Dr. John Newdorp was read about kayaking. He is to be written telling him his information is incorrect and send him a pamphlet.

Tom Hansen was put on probation for one year for a fish and game violation of spot lighting deer.

The board reviewed the personnel commission's notice on grievance procedure and tabled the discussion until next meeting when a grievance committee should be appointed.

The board suggested a completed training list for boaters be sent each week to Mike, Challis National Forest and Salmon National Forest.

Applications were reviewed.

The board recessed at 5:00.

Wednesday, April 20, the board reconvened at 9:00 with James Baughman, Lon Jarvis and Bill Guth present.

Lon Jarvis made a motion that "We will write each outfitter who writes "yes" to guiding on his application and does not have a Red Cross card or their card is about to expire, telling him he must have a copy of his first aid card into the office before the beginning of his season as the law enforcement officer will be there to check his license." Seconded by Bill Guth and passed unanimously.

Clyde Seeley and F. W. Howell, two outfitter applicants from West Yellowstone, Montana, applying for snowmobiling met with the board and was told they must submit managing agent applications as both applications that were received were for corporations.

The board continued reviewing outfitter and guide license applications.

May 19 and 20 was set as the dates for the next board meeting.

The attached list for outfitter and guide licenses that were approved, denied and extended is attached and is a part of these minutes.

The meeting adjourned at 5:00.
