

## OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

July 25, 26 & 27, 1977

The Outfitters and Guides Board met on Monday, July 25, at 9:00 A.M., with the following members present: James Baughman, Vice-Chairman, Bill Guth and Lon Jarvis. Outfitter and guide applications were reviewed and approved. The board discussed the number of Spelts's hunting guide applications in relation to the number of hunters he is allowed to take.

In a telephone call to the Fish and Game Department, the board was informed their new board member would be appointed at the F & G meeting on August 11th.

The board discussed John Vail's outfitter application, and also the trip the Alpine Tours for Teens from Colorado made on the Salmon River. The board decided to hold John J. Moriarty's guide application until his Fish & Game trial is complete.

The minutes of the June meeting were read and approved.

Letters from the Attorney General's office, with a legal opinion on a proposed rule and regulation; Parks & Recreation; David Petersen; Dan M. Hamilton & Bob Rosso, all on proposed rules & regulations, were read.

The board recessed for lunch and reconvened at 1:00 P.M., with the same members present.

Dr. Wood, III and Stuart Carty met with the board to discuss an outfitter application for Dr. Wood. The board discouraged him on his big game application and his complete application and bond was returned to him, for reconsideration.

Rex Lanham arrived at 1:30 P.M.

Mr. & Mrs. Jim Walker met with the board to discuss a new outfitter application. The board asked the secretary to check with Mr. Holtus, Forest Service manager on the Snake River, before a decision would be made on the application.

A letter from R. B. Rivers about float boating the Snake and lower Salmon was discussed, and a letter is to be written advising him he must have Forest Service approval before his license extension can be taken under advisement.

The proposed rules and regulations were discussed and Lon made a motion to approve the rules and regulations, as amended; seconded by Bill Guth, and unanimously approved.

The board started to discuss the proposed changes in the law.

Recessed at 5:30 P.M.

Tuesday, July 26, the board reconvened at 8:15 A.M., with the following members present: Rex Lanham, Chairman, James Baughman, Vice-Chairman, Lon Jarvis and Bill Guth--Mike Wilkins, Investigator, was also present.

Shirley Sevy of Zee Medical Service, Boise, met with the board to show them some first aid equipment.

The board discussed John Jones' case, and appointed Bill Guth to be hearing officer for this hearing.

A suggestion was made to write the parents of the children who took the Alpine Tours for Teens Salmon River trip and cite the law about guide requirements, tell them about the children and lady who almost drowned, and advise them to check on a company's license before they let their children go on a trip.

John Jones and his attorney, John Insinger, arrived for John Jones' hearing. Guy Hurlbutt, the board's attorney from the Attorney General's office, was present. After some discussion, it was agreed to have a hearing with a formal hearing officer at a date set by the attorneys.

The board recessed for lunch and reconvened at 1:00 P.M., with the same members present.

Leonard Hulse met with the board to discuss a new outfitter license application. Mr. Hulse stated that he charged \$25 a day, and if a guest/<sup>was skunked</sup> he returned \$7.50. He stated he would take no more than six guests at a time, and wanted to hunt ducks, chukar, & quail, and said he would take a partial license if the board would not approve all of the application.

Al Lockett met with the board to discuss his operation and Paul Henry, an unlicensed guide he used last year. Mr. Lockett said Paul Henry retired last year. Mr. Lockett asked to have fishing added to his license.

John Vail's outfitter application was discussed, then Mr. Vail met with the board to discuss his problems. Mr. Vail said he was morally innocent, but maybe technically guilty of his citation, and how would the board view his license if he pled guilty? The board told Mr. Vail, they would review and process his application as soon as possible, and the board would not be prejudice whether he did or did not plead guilty, but would not under any conditions promise him he would get a license.

Some more proposed changes in the law was discussed.

Recessed at 5:45 P.M.

Wednesday, July 27, the meeting reconvened at 10:00 A.M., with Rex Lanham, James Baughman and Lon Jarvis present.

Jerry Reese, ranger from North Fork called, inquiring about John Jones and Martin Capps' river trips. They both had trips leaving the same day on Martin Capps' permit.

Dennis Holton, Forest Service ranger in Wallowa-Whitman forest, was telephoned to discuss R. B. Rivers application for float boating, and he told the board all outfitters need permits for day use and the Forest Service does not want to allow permits for partial sections of the river that they have designated.

The board approved Wynn Agee's outfitter application; and the refund to the Idaho Outfitters & Guides Association of Wayne Robinson's outfitter license fee they had payed, as the check he payed to them was returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

The board telephoned Mr. Snook, Prosecuting Attorney of Lemhi County, to inquire whether John Vail had given a guilty plea, and if so, what was the court's decision. Mr. Furey, John Vail's attorney, called to inform the board Mr. Vail had plead guilty, and his fine was paid. The board approved Mr. Vail's application and the license was issued.

The board discussed the outfitter application of Jerry Spear and Ron Chandler, and denied Jerry Spear's application, since the Forest Service will not give him a permit as he stated he had sold his business to Ron Chandler. Ron Chandler has to have his application signed by the Forest Service and send us a copy of his sales contract with Jerry Spear, before his application can be acted upon.

Letters from Harry Lewies and Lyle Kunz about Laren Piquet's area; Clint-Graham Co., about a break-in; copy of Frank Comiskey's letter to Henry-Rust & Co., about claim on George May's bond; Department of Administration on rules and regulations pertaining to the "Retained Risk Fund"; Letter from John B. Conti with a complaint about bear hunting with Lewis Blair Harrington; James C. Herndon, about a transfer of Stanton C. Miller's power boating operation on Main Salmon to Jack Smith; Office of the Governor, on savings bonds; Henry-Rust & Co., with carbon copy of a letter from George Jensen on a claim against Dale Ney, were all read and discussed.

The outfitter applications of Jim Walker and Leonard Hulse were approved by Rex Lanham and Lon Jarvis.

The board approved buying a camera for Mike.

Recessed for lunch.

The meeting reconvened after lunch at 1:30 P.M., with the same members present.

The proposed changes in the law were discussed and will be sent to our attorney at the Attorney General's office, to be written and presented to the Governor's office.

A list of the outfitters and guides licenses which were approved, denied, or extended, is attached as a part of these minutes.

The meeting adjourned at 4:15 P.M.
