

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

April 19 & 20, 1978

The Outfitters and Guides Board meet on April 19, at 8:30 a. m. with Rex Lanham, Chairman, James Baughman, Lon Jarvis and Ivol Sies present.

The board reviewed a letter from Scott Farr, Ron Malone, Gary Madsen and Ken Smith about cougar hunting and a letter is to be written telling this is approved.

The board reviewed Bob Smith's application and a decision was made that he should pay \$10 for an addition to his original application.

A letter was read from Homer Saye of Houston, Texas stating what a good hunt he had with Scott Farr last fall, but that the pilot Bruce Minter was not a credit to the profession.

The board set a policy that from now on a letter will be written for approval from all outfitters who are licensed in an area before considering putting a new outfitter in their area for any activity.

A letter from James M. Tardif about not receiving his pay from Lyle Phelps was read. A letter is to be written to Mr. Phelps inquiring about him not paying his help. This is the third letter from guides who have not been paid.

The board instructed the secretary to return the information received from Ken Jacks on insurance grazing permit request to forest service.

Guy Hurlbutt, our attorney from the Attorney General's office, arrived. There was a discussion on the court decision of the Grand Canyon Dorries case. Ivol Sies made the following motion: "The Outfitters and Guides Board will not appeal the judges decision on nonresident outfitters and guides fees in the Grand Canyon Dorries case." Seconded by James Baughman and passed unanimously.

Bill Guth arrived at 9:45 a.m.

A discussion was held on the stipulations of Stanton Miller's case. Lon Jarvis made the following motion: "The Outfitters and Guides Board will accept the hearing officers decision on the Stanton Miller case." Seconded and passed unanimously.

Guy Hurlbutt advised that a letter should be sent to all outfitters notifying them that nonresident outfitter and guide license fees will be the same as resident outfitters and guide license fees as of March 17, 1978, and the additional fees received on all applications postmarked as of March 17 and after will be refunded.

Guy also advised us to write a letter to attention of Rudy Barchus asking to advise if George May's brochure violated the consumer protection act in any way. He also advised writing a letter to David Leroy Ada County Prosecuting Attorney, about Dean McGuire signing Joe Wilson's signature to his guide application and what action could be taken.

Guy reported that the judge in the John Rose case had asked for briefs and this had been done.

Guy Hurlbutt said he would check to see what it would take to apply for a special appropriation from the Governor's office should the board need to apply.

Guy will meet with some of the board members on Monday to give some legal advise on some of the problems on the applications.

Phil Swanstrom, investigator, reported on what he had found out about Don Waller, a new outfitter applicant, and the Helms/Bridges complaint on being harassed by two Idaho guides. The guides were Whitten and Sargent.

Don Waller and Dave Howard meet with the board to discuss forming a partnership under the name of True Trophies, for the area Don Waller had applied for.

The board recessed for lunch and reconvened at 1:00 with James Baughman, Lon Jarvis, Bill Guth and Ivol Sies present.

The board discussed the boat training trips and the pros and cons of allowing guides to take one or two trips on the rivers before the outfitters sent in their applications for a license.

Richard Baker and Richard Saxton meet with the board to apply for boating on the lower Salmon from Spring Bar to Snake; Snake River from Salmon River to Lewiston and Clearwater River from Kooskia to Lewiston. The board advised them that as far as we know the lower Salmon quota was full, but there were openings on the Snake and Clearwater Rivers. They decided they would not be interested in any until they could be on the lower Salmon. They asked to have a letter written to them when the licensing was completed to tell them where they are on the priority list.

Joe Anderson meet with the board to discuss becoming managing agent for Timber Ridge Lodge. The board told him they did not see any problems, but he needs a completed application before a decision would be made.

James Campbell meet with the board to discuss what he would have to do to transfer all the business except float boating on the Middle Fork and Snake River which he is planning to sell this portion of his business. Mr. Campbell also asked about getting training cards without Red Cross cards, and waiting until after two trips on the river had been taken to send in an application. He was told that as it was in the rules and regulations that a complete application with Red Cross card must be sent to the office before a training card could be issued, that was how he would have to do it. Mr. Campbell said he would try to find someone to teach a Red Cross class as he had a man to send on a training trip immediately even if it didn't count.

Bob Rosso of the Elephants Perch, meet with the board to discuss a cross country skiing, backpacking and technical mountaineering outfitter license. He has to obtain a forest ranger's signature and correct his bond before the board will review his application.

The board's decision on the Howard-Waller partnership was that Dave Howard would be managing agent of the partnership, as he would do all the bookings and paper work and Don Waller would be the guide, and would have to apply for a guide license, as he does the actual guiding.

Richard Clark of Ricks College meet with the board to explain their programs. They would have 25-35 persons per class and 3-4 a year. He was advised to stay out of any thing that would be considered outfitting and stay with the educational part of their trips. We will ask the Attorney General's Office for an official opinion on educational trips relating to outfitting and then advise Mr. Clark.

The board decided Mr. Lockett should not pay an additional fee of \$50 as his bond was a continuation certificate which his bonding company was to send direct to us, and everything else was in our office before March 16.

Harold Spelts' application was discussed. Larry Weeks of fish and game will be written for input on all activities applied for before a decision is made.

The board recessed at 5:00 p.m.

Wednesday, April 20, the board reconvened at 8:30 a.m. with Rex Lanham, James Baughman and Ivol Sies present.

Joe Pecks' complaint was discussed.

A letter from Mrs. Hinks complaining about the additional \$50 was read.

R. B. Rivers application was discussed. A letter is to be written asking him if he uses federal land, and if so he must have their signature.

A telephone call was received from Bill Webb approving cougar hunting in Unit 54 for Larry Walker and Ron Malone.

A copy of a letter from Norman Guth written to Ronald Estep about his complaint was read.

A reply from the board to Mr. Nick's about the Crick complaint was read.

A letter from Cecil Sanford about Larry Fiddler was read. The letter stated he was mostly an educational firm and booked for people in Wyoming, Montana and Alaska.

The board placed Lyle Phelps and Duane Beale on one year probation.

The Sawtooth Mountaineering extention for trips into the SNRA was approved as of the forest service letter of 1/26/78.

The board reviewed Wally York's complaint and his reply to Lloyd Webb. A letter will be written to Mr. Webb telling him the board feels Mr. York is a competent outfitter.

May 15 & 16 will be the next board meeting.

A list of outfitters and guides licenses who have been approved, denied, and extended are attached and become part of these minutes.

The meeting adjourned at 12:00 noon.
