

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

July 10, 1978

Boise, Idaho

The Outfitters and Guides Board met July 10, 1978, at 8:30 a.m. with the following members present: Rex Lanham, Chairman, James F. Baughman, Lon Jarvis, Bill Guth, and Ivol Sies.

Jim Rennie's reply to the board's letter about CWA programs in Idaho was read and discussed.

Minutes of the June 12 & 13 meeting was read and approved.

The board discussed the rules and regulations, they will be completed and sent to the printer.

A letter from Richard Linford asking about a solo training trip, but including his family, and the board's reply was read.

The ^{Guide} application of Tim Robertson was approved, but he is to be required to submit a log of his experience.

Forrest Garrigus's letter about his outfitter application was read again and discussed. A certified letter will be sent with a photo copy of a previous letter written on March 30, 1978. He will be advised of the new outfitter license fees and reminded that he will have to pay a late fee.

The ^{Outfitter} application of Philip Smith will be accepted, but he will be required to obtain the signature of the forest service ranger at Idaho City.

Bob Smith of Kooskia telephoned and talked to the board about a bow hunting area. The board advised him the area he applied for was licensed to other outfitters.

The board made the following policy concerning licenses: All qualified activities for guiding must be put on a license for an outfitter and/or guide when they apply for it. It will be put on the back of the guide license if the employing outfitter is not licensed for the activity they apply for, or on the back of an outfitter's license if he is not licensed for the activity.

Tom Woolstenhulme's outfitter application was reviewed. Lon Jarvis made a motion that a late fee not be charged, this was seconded by James Baughman. Mr. Baughman and Mr. Jarvis voted aye, and Mr. Sies no - the motion passed.

William Bender's file was reviewed. The letter written to Mr. Bender from the board requesting Mr. Bender to send his original Red Cross Card to the office was read. No reply has been received - another letter will be written.

A letter from Dwight Cleveland requesting his guide license fee be refunded was read. A letter of reply will be written advising Mr. Cleveland that the law states that a refund cannot be made on new applications.

A letter from Brown, Webb and Dennis commending the Guth Brothers on their outfitting business, and a complaint against John Booker was read.

A copy of a letter from Earl Dodds to Dave Stucker was read.

A letter from Everett Peirce criticising the increase in outfitter license fees, and the late fee was read. The board made a decision that as Mr. Peirce's bond was a continuation from the previous year that the late fee would not be charged. A letter will be written advising him of this, and also advising him that the bond must be in the mail before March 31, of the license year.

The board recessed for lunch and reconvened at 1:00 p.m. with James Baughman, Lon Jarvis, and Ivol Sies present.

A guide license application from Richard Baker was approved and the license and training cards sent.

A letter from Larry Moats about his outfitter license was read and discussed. A letter is to be written telling him of his position on the priority list on the lower Salmon (Spring Bar to Snake River) for float boating, and giving him power boating on this section of the Salmon River if he wants it.

A copy of a letter from Greg H. Bower to the prosecuting attorney of Idaho County about Dean McGuire was read.

A letter from Dean McGuire requesting his application to be returned was read.

A letter from the auditors office about the travel allowances effective July 1, 1978 was read, also reports from Cecil Sanford and Philip Swanstrum.

Guy Hurlbutt, from the Attorney General's office, met with the board and discussed the board's request for an official opinion on whether schools are outfitting or not. They also discussed the letter from Jim Rennie. A letter will be written to Mr. Rennie advising him that the board's official position is to care for the health and welfare of the public. Mr. Hurlbutt and the board also discussed Stanton Miller's letter about the board's questionnaire. Mr. Hurlbutt will write a letter stating the board wants a complete list of all his customers within ten-days after a trips is taken.

Marilyn Loening met with the board to see if the board would approve an application for her step-daughter, Lynn Loening, to take over the summer activities her father had. They have 102 acres on Cripple Creek, and there is a possibility that Gary Madsen might assist them. The board could see no problems, but would have to have a completed application before any decision would be made.

A letter from Bill Barlow complimenting Eldon Handy, the scouts and plane service for helping him when his boat tipped over on the Middle Fork, and he broke his leg, was read.

A copy of a contract, written in November 1977, between John Jones and Beamer's Heller Bar appointing Mr. Jones managing agent on the Main Salmon River from Corn Creek to Spring Bar was reviewed. A letter is to be written to Mrs. Beamer inquiring if this contract is in effect.

A telephone call from Sun Valley Company inquiring if a license would be needed for mountain climbing on their own private man made rock. It was the board's decision that a license would not be required.

A letter from Jerry Hughes with a copy of a brochure from the Flying H Ranch was read and discussed. Investigation action will be taken.

A letter from Jim Higgins stating he would not be managing agent for Sulpher Creek this year, and that George Truppi would apply for the managing agent position, was read.

A telephone call from Dan Cowan of Las Vegas, Nevada was received about trying to obtain a refund from Quentin Selby for a goose hunting trip that was never taken this past year. A letter is to be written to Mr. Selby asking about this complaint.

A copy of the Release and Satisfaction of Judgement in the John Rose case was brought to the board's attention.

Letters on Workmen's Compensation Laws, insurance from the retirement system, and a letter from Cecil Sanford about Wayne Beuke were read.

A date for the next board meeting will be set at a later date.

The meeting adjourned at 5:00 p.m.
