

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

July 17-19, 1979

Boise, Idaho

Tuesday, July 17, 1979 at 8:30 A.M. the regular meeting of the Outfitters and Guides Board met with three members present: Vice-Chairman James Baughman, Lon Jarvis and Ivol Sies.

The corrected minutes of February 12 - 14 were reviewed and approved by motion of Ivol, seconded by Lon and passed.

Guide Verle Duerden, partner in Western River Expeditions, Inc., apology letter to the Board and the Board's response was read. Lon suggested that a copy of Duerden's letter and the Board's letter be made available to the Association's boating committee, for their understanding since the comments were made at that meeting.

Bill Guth joined the meeting at 9:30 A.M., and the May 25 & 26 meeting minutes were read, and approved, after corrections, by motion of Lon, seconded by Bill and passed.

Complaints and Investigations were reviewed: (1) the Forest Services federal court case against Forrest Gus Garrigus, and the news item reporting a temporary restraining order has denied him boating on Hell's Canyon stretch of the Snake River; (2) Outfitter Timothy Gardiner, Hailey, letter complaining of Sun Valley Co. in same area without licensed guides. Maps were checked and Lon will personally look into the problem and report back; (3) Suspected date alteration on Red Cross card photocopies submitted for guide licenses were brought up and the reports of the meetings with board members were read of Jack Garnsey, Sanford, Maine on June 18 and Roger Ellis, Rogue River, Oregon on June 29, in which they both admitted they had altered their cards; Merrill Zilkowsky, Springfield, Oregon has also been notified to appear before the Board about his card. He is currently on Idaho rivers is the word received and cannot make his appointment for this meeting. The Board determined that a letter be mailed to him and his outfitter, Dean Helfrich of the implications involved because of his current unlicensed status. The Board further determined that those Red Cross Chapters, who have issued the cards should be notified. (4) Karla Hayes, guide training for Richard Jones, who has submitted invalid training according to the rules and regulations was discussed. Bill mentioned she says she has witnesses of training trip and may go to court to prove it.

Boating was discussed and problems of training; also the first aid kits are not what the boating committee wanted in their suggested new rules, Bill pointed out. All board members agreed, that the training card aspect of the rules and regulations is not working out - encumbering all concerned as well as causing an overload of work, therefore should be junked unanimously agreed; the Board will work on new rules as soon as possible.

The notes of Attorney Guy Hurlbutt's meeting with board members Rex Lanham, Jim Baughman and Ivol Sies on July 2nd were read and will be incorporated into these minutes as follows: Decisions were made to make an exception by the Board to rules 26 (d) and (e) and 28, second paragraph, in the case of Eldon Handy's low water training request (telephone conversation of June 29). The Board made this exception by citing Idaho Code 2107 (d) and advised Mr. Handy by letter dated July 2, 1979; an exception to rule number 26 (d) and (e) was made also on the training submitted for the guides of Woodrow Hassinger, M.A. for Frontier Expeditions, Inc., as he has submitted signed statements and some trips were witnessed by our enforcement officer. This exception also was in accordance with Idaho Code 2107 (d) and Mr. Hassinger was advised by letters as his various guides' documents were received; and finally it was determined that the Board would contact the Forest

Service controlling the permit issuance on the Snake River, Hell's Canyon Dam to Lewiston to see if there are others, than Grand Canyon Dories with a permit to operate, to consider prior to issuance of Grand Canyon Dories this license, in fairness to all who serve the public.

Richard Clark, Professor of Outdoor Experience and Resources, Ricks College, Rexburg again met with the Board. He explained their problem in getting licensed - so many departments in the school hold what could be guided activities (although no money involved), too costly to pay licensed guides. There was much discussion, which included Clark's request that the Board relook at their guide situation, as well as requesting canoeing on rivers already licensed to the maximum. The conclusion was the same as before, river use could be handled through existing river outfitters, and Clark said he will take Lon's suggestion and license only his department - for backpacking and trailrides in the Tetons at present. Mr. Clark also said he may take their problem to the Attorney General's office, as they feel they should be exempt from the rules that were not specifically written for their teaching situation.

The Board then recessed for a late lunch.

At 1:55 P.M., the Board reconvened with all members, except Rex Lanham present, and with Harlan and Duane Opdahl of Pierce, Idaho in attendance. The Opdahl brothers have obtained the business that was originally licensed as H & M Outfitters and involved Albert M. Hettinger and Samuel L. Miller, Usk, Washington, but this past year only licensed to Samuel L. Miller. The Board advised of problems arising from overbooking and shooting guests' game to avoid getting complaints. Applications were incomplete, as no bond. Harlan will be M.A. outfitter and Duane, licensed outfitter partner. An overpayment on the fee was discussed, and Opdahl's advised the office to hold the \$50.00 overpaid for a guide license to be obtained later.

Richard Dean Justus and wife, Hermiston, Oregon, met with the Board at 2:30 P.M. regarding the outfitting area presently licensed to Herman Konrad. They have purchased private-owned 1½ acres from Konrad and he is releasing to them his assigned area for outfitting. Lon requested that a written statement be sent to the Board from Konrad on three hunters he has booked, and Jim pointed out area was over hunted and problems that could come about. Then the right of way requested by Harold Thomas into his ranch through their area was discussed. Agreed that Board would, at the time of licensing, assign a trail access to Allison Ranch which would have joint-use rights.

Investigation and Complaints were then continued: Cecil's citation of Kellum's house boat tours named "The Whatever", on the Snake River behind Lower Granite Dam. The Kellum's maintain this is deadwater and under the Corps of Engineers jurisdiction, but Cecil says they cruise up to the Clearwater River; then Ivol's report on George May's fine money being paid at Grangeville court that would have 50% paid to the Board by August 15; and then the fine monies from Lemhi County still not paid was noted and our attorney's report that his letters are unanswered and suggests only recourse is a claim against the clerk's bond - Bill volunteered to discuss problem with Attorney Snook.

At 4:10 P.M., outfitter Ken Smith and new outfitter applicant, Bill Crombie, and Ron Malone, Challis met with the Board - first, about Smith's transfer of his presently licensed area to Bill Crombie, Los Angeles, policeman. The Board mentioned they had knowledge because of advertising received, but no application submitted, and Mr. Crombie has been made aware of the implications by telephone conversation and a letter dated June 4 from the Board. Bill mentioned that boundaries between Vaughn and Crombie need to be reviewed and when his application is submitted, he should reappear before the Board. Smith said he wanted to be sure Crombie did not lose on the overlap area and that he himself had not been aware of Vaughn having joint-use in there until he saw it marked on the office map in December, 1977. Smith then mentioned that he would be taking his bookings with him, except he has retained the sheep hunting right in that area released to Crombie. Second reason for meeting with the Board: Ken Smith explained that he and Ron Malone have reached an agreement on a split of area presently licensed to Malone, with Smith getting licensed for the old Flying Dutchman (Ish Martin) area, and Malone having joint-use. They would also set up written permission for joint-use of all area between them. The Board said it would have to be on a year to year basis, and asked about Forest Service approval. Malone explained that Seamons not favorable to another outfitter in area, also he has had trouble with use of forest service airstrip. No applications, no release of area, so no decision, but Malone asked about getting area back if deal with Smith did not work out - Board said probable, but could have complications.

Ron Malone asked about the cougar area that was licensed on his 1979-80 license and that of Scott Farr, Ken Smith and Gary Madsen - Board looked at map and determined the wrong area description was assigned. It will be corrected on all four outfitters. Bear/cougar hunting being opened state-wide was discussed but agreed it could have adverse results - ie, selling of cougar hunting rights, etc. Ken Smith was warned not to overly advertise the sheep hunting as it gives one outfitter an advantage over others to hunt special permittees, as they left the meeting.

The Board recessed at 5:25 P.M. by motion made by Iv01, Lon seconded and the motion passed.

Wednesday, July 18, 1979

The board meeting reconvened at 8:30 A.M. with Chairman Rex Lanham, Jim Baughman, Lon Jarvis and Iv01 Sies present.

Applications were reviewed and approved.

Miscellaneous outfitter business was presented: (1) Jeff and Max Bitton, Mountain Home, extension of area request was discussed and Fish and Game letters read. The decision, passed by all members present, was: One year trial basis license for 8-guests only for area - Fox Creek, Pine Creek and Sheep Creek drainages - this area not to be combined with original hunting area; (2) Victor and Gene Frederickson's Kootenai River Outfitters and Guides of Bonners Ferry, Idaho applications are incomplete but as requested, meeting with Board will be waived; and (3) Edward McCallum, Priest River, Idaho letter was read whereby his spring bear hunting was closed in Unit 1 and requests more area.

The meeting was interrupted by a telephone call from Tom Drinville, Darby, Montana about packing supplies into Don Habel's area this week - Jim and Lon talked on call and gave tentative approval, as a copy of Habel's approval and Drinville's letter are forthcoming he said.

At 9:50 A.M. Edward Houghton, Chestertown, Maryland and George Matteson, Grangeville met with the Board about transfer of Matteson area to Houghton. Three-Prong hunting camp was determined to be in Wally York area and would have to be moved. Also past campsite conflicts with outfitters Richie and Wolfinbarger were discussed and maps checked. Matteson has not booked clients he said and will license as guide and help Houghton. Application was incomplete, no bond.

Outfitter business was continued: (4) Jerry Meyer's, Salmon application for old Gillespie area was tabled for answer from Fish and Game and still incomplete; (5) Bill Mason, M.A. for Snug Co. being cited and fined for out of area activity was noted; (6) Larry Jarrett file and Board's letters were reviewed; (7) Fish and Game's concern over Errol Arford's broad based advertising for fly fishing - no definite area named, so no complaint says Board; (8) Mike Carey and Kenneth Warren, Portland river deal not complete but Warren is operating on Snake River was reported; (9) Tim Craig, Lewiston, application for licensing Lochsa River boating, and trailrides combined, and the Forest Service's letter of nonapproval of his request were reviewed. It was motioned by Jim, seconded by Ivöl and passed that his license extension be delayed until fall for Craig to get his qualifications and then review his application again, for approval or denial; (10) Dave Howard, True Trophys and Donald Waller's agreement whereby they have dissolved the partnership was reviewed. Don Waller will outfit the business licensed as True Trophys on his own. Dave Howard has obtained the old Enos Kimball area and will continue his own area. Also Payette Forest Service letter was read which will not give a permit to Waller for additional area; (11) Steve Jordan's clients complimentary letter was read on Birds of Prey float trip; (12) Idaho Vacation's letter from Attorney Park advising that James Powell has been dismissed as managing agent for their outfitter business; (13) Robert Meeks, Lewiston inquiry about river canoeing; and (14) Morten Fadum's inquiry about licensing lake boating and fishing were read - letters will be sent, Attorney General's opinion to be quoted to Mr. Fadum.

After lunch recess, the Board reconvened with all members present except Bill Guth; also present were Attorney Guy Hurlbutt and Attorney Bill Latta. The enforcement men's overtime pay was discussed, as was the problems caused by the new rules and regulations. It was explained by Rex that all board members have agreed that the training card procedure is not working out and the rules and regulations must be changed to put the responsibility of training back on the outfitter. Guy says to set a formal hearing date for changes on rules and regulations and get input but must be soon for next season.

The overtime accumulated daily that Mike has claimed for compensation will be paid at regular rate, but auditor will not allow pay through time required to consume the meals. Attorneys Latta and Hurlbutt agreed that the Board should inform Mike that his agreement with the Board is to a total of 864 work hours per year and the explanation of how he should allot those hours to only 8-hour days must be returned to so that his service may be available over the entire year, if he plans to keep on working for the Board. Also increase of pay was questioned, no problem if budget will allow, says Mr. Latta, and that travel pay may increase soon.

Guy Hurlbutt was questioned by Rex about his rumored notice to resign as Board's attorney as of September 1. Mr. Baughman explained his contact with the Attorney General's office and offered his apology, Guy said that was not the problem for his decision, only the Board's lack of funds which has caused him to underbill for his services, but that he would hold off awhile and see how it goes.

The two attorneys left the meeting at 3:00 P.M., and outfitter business was continued: (15) Richard Jones' request for special float trips for August 3, August 11, August 17, and September 14. In reviewing his letter the Board determined that it would be approved if he obtained enough guides to hold to 1 per 5 sport-yaks - a letter listing these conditions will be mailed to Jones and a copy to Mike. Then the notes of Richard Jones' meeting with board members, Rex, Jim and Ivol, was read and discussed, on his problems with Mike and getting his guides trained per the rules and regulations: Jones claimed Idaho only state he has problems with and operates in Utah, Arizona and Colorado and he plans to spearhead a change for the December meeting. He further claimed Federal regulations were all that was needed, as works in Utah and no "Mike" causing trouble, and claimed boating committee now a farce. He stated that he would like to be on Board, or some other boater such as Litton, Hughes or Miller. The Board finally said, until they are changed, they expected him to abide by Idaho's rules and regulations same as other outfitters have to; (16) Forest Service's letter on settling boundary dispute with Keating and Cummings was read; (17) Board determined that Forest Service be contacted on total permittees prior to issuance of Grand Canyon Dorries/Curtis Chang, M.A. extensions; (18) Ken Jackson, Coeur d'Alene, outfitter applicant on new rivers, and (19) Dan Rotthoff's dispute of license which did not include the South Fork of Payette River - decision that board would license him from Alder Creek Bridge to mouth of Middle Fork of Payette, nontransferrable, with no cut-off dates, by motion made by Lon, seconded by Ivol and passed.

Rex left the meeting at 4:35 P.M., and miscellaneous outfitter business was continued: (20) Gladys York being out of area into Buffalo Hump area in Gospel Mountains, as was reported by Forest Service; and (21) Jack F. Wemple being in Timber Ridge area as reported by Forest Service and Agee's letter of complaint about Wemple was reviewed.

By motion made by Lon, seconded by Ivol, the meeting recessed at 5:15 P.M.

Thursday, July 19, 1979

The meeting reconvened with Rex, Jim and Ivol in attendance, at 8:30 A.M.

Attorney Hurlbutt's May and June legal service statements were reviewed. Then outfitter business was finished: (22) Forest Service's complaint about Dale Jennings's, Peck, Idaho, dogs running game in pursuit of cougar; (23) Don Habel's use of area and late license application was reviewed and approved; (24) Rex mentioned again (as in May 24 meeting) that he wanted it on record that he be considered for area licensed to Big Creek Recreation, Ltd. if they do not apply; (25) and finally, miscellaneous letters written to outfitters by board members were noted and read.

Boating business was then worked on: the priority on the lower Salmon River to Snake River and Snake River, Salmon River to Lewiston was checked and determined that the one opening would be allowed to Holiday River Expeditions, Inc. with Harold "Frog" Stewart, M.A., as the release given by Bob Smith included these two sections even though Stewart did not apply until a later date.

Then the priority for Chuck Boyd and Johnny Joe Bryant, James Henry Katz and Richard Barker was reviewed - it was determined that letters be sent to all on their priority status. Also letters would be written to those with no use, Zapffe, and others to voluntarily relinquish their float boating.

The meeting recessed at 10:30 A.M. as Rex left the meeting and reconvened at 2:00 P.M., as Rex rejoined Jim and Ivol and boating business was continued. LuVerne Grussing, B.L.M., Cottonwood was called about river use - Board's decision was not to add the section of Snake River from Salmon River to Lewiston to Lower Salmon license holders until next year to see who is using, then extend.

A letter, forwarded from Fish and Game about a Charles Maggi, Jr., Chico, California hunter against an unnamed outfitter and guide, was read.

Then State business was reviewed: (1) Board decision was to reinstate Inland Marine Insurance on office equipment; (2) State Insurance Fund director, Don Barklow to be contacted to see what has happened on Continental Insurance refund due the office; (3) IBM yearly service contract, (\$137.50) - board will not renew; (4) audit notice and cost of last audit, almost \$500, in February, 1977; (5) IPC's request for an Administrative Procedure Manual set up for each agency; (6) new adding machine/calculator purchased at \$119.00.

New business included the conference at McCall on September 16, 17, and 18 being conducted by Idaho Recreation and Park Society, in which Hugh Cooke has asked for a member of the Board to set in on the panel on September 18th. Ivol said he would consider attending, to represent the Board.

Licenses which have been approved, extended, denied or amended since May 25, 1979 have been listed and are included as a part of these minutes.

The Board meeting adjourned at 4:45 P.M., with a tentative date for the next meeting to be in the last part of August.
