

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

September 12, 1979

Boise, Idaho

Friday at 8:40 a.m., the following members of the Outfitters and Guides Board convened for a board meeting: Vice-Chairman Jim Baughman, Ivol Sies and Lon Jarvis.

Wages and budget were discussed. The Board's budget analyst had called to advise the wages had been budgeted low and there might be a problem.

Then it was brought to the Board's attention that Pat's training had not been reviewed and that she had taken additional typing to increase her skill and it should be reviewed. The Board then, by motion of Lon and Ivol's second, voted to increase Pat's wages effective September 1, 1979, to show their appreciation in her extra effort to increase her typing ability. The secretary was instructed to advise Pat and reevaluate her work for this increase.

Applications were reviewed and approved for licensing. Then William Crombie and his guides applications were approved after discussion that decided that the bond number has been called and the office was assured it was in effect or the number would not have been given, but to request the bond be sent immediately.

The meeting with William Crombie was again talked of, and Steve Currey's request for information on the boat ramp complaint was discussed. The Board determined that they would write Mr. Currey that notice of his apology was extended to the complainants and that should complete this complaint.

The next Board meeting date was set for October 9 and 10, 1979.

The Board then recessed for lunch and the afternoon flight and meeting at Lewiston.

The four board members arrived back in Boise at 8:00 p.m., and adjourned their meeting.
