

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

June 5 & 6, 1980

Thursday, June 5, the Outfitters and Guides Board convened at 9:00 A.M., with Vice - Chairman Baughman presiding, Bill, Ivol and Eldon in attendance. Rex is out of state.

Dave Giles, Salmon, was the first appointment meeting with the Board, about an enforcement/investigator job. The nature of the job was explained and that he would be hired on a part-time basis, with 8-hour day pay -- no overtime. Dave explained his obligation to Salmon River Lodge he has just sold which includes some guiding for them this year. There was discussion on guiding and enforcement work being a conflict of interest. It was determined that Dave would not guide during time of Board work. The Board will direct work to some extent -- Dave has available a jet boat, horses and mules for Board's use and would be willing to go anywhere he's sent.

After Dave left the meeting, (Bill left too), the enforcement work of Randy Ross and Mike Wilkins was discussed. There was talk about Mike being called in; also to assign him to eastern Idaho.

Two phone calls were taken: Jim received word that outfitter Jim Sweeney (39) had died May 23, 1980. It was advised that the Board would work with Mrs. Sweeney for this year while she gets things straightened out--she will take care of the hunters booked. Also Ivol talked to new applicant Doug Cremer about his bear hunting area requested being restricted by Fish and Game.

At 11:00 A.M., prior to Dewey Cavin, Jerome meeting with the Board about an investigator/enforcement job, Eldon explained a law suit from Cavin's outfitting when a client's boy was drown in Haystack Rapids below the Flying B on the Middle Fork, which ended in a \$9,000.00 judgement against him. Eldon said Dewey has four sons himself and this ended his outfitting business. He further explained that he was in partnership with him two years; that he is smart and wants into enforcement business. He's run for Jerome County sheriff twice unsuccessfully and is available to start immediately. His resume was read, which includes 11 years of outfitting and guiding, then he was called in. It was explained that it was a part time job only with possible 100-140 days work a year. His past record was discussed and in response to Ivol he said he was not involved in politics. Dewey has a camper and horses available, and answered he would be willing to go anywhere, but prefers the Middle Fork.

Following this appointment the Board recessed for lunch.

At 1:15 P.M., the four Board members reconvened (Rex absent), and a phone call received by the secretary from Mike about two boating accidents already on the river -- Mackay Bar jet boat and Grand Canyon Dories float boat collision, on the Main Salmon River and Western Rivers upset on the Middle Fork of a 20-foot pontoon boat in Powerhouse Rapids. Mike also mentioned his work this season. Then Board members Jim, Bill and Eldon called Rex in Reno and determined that Mike will be asked to come in for a meeting with the Board on June 10, 1980, as it is agreed that continued work on the rivers would be an unfavorable situation.

At 2:00 P.M., the appointment with David Taff, Prosser, Washington was about a big game hunting area near his friend, outfitter Harold Hodges, which proved to be already licensed to other outfitters with exception of a too small area for an outfitter operation. This was explained and he may seek another area, prior to action on his application.

At 2:30 P. M., G. J. Carter, Spokane, Washington met again with the Board about licensing as a bear hunter outfitter in game unit No. 4 -- he has been denied hunting in Unit 1 only. His request was for both areas. The Board apologized for the oversight.

At 3:30 P. M., the Board's attorney, Guy Hurlbutt, joined the meeting about the scheduled hearing, June 23rd requested by outfitter applicants, Willis Benjamin and William Bishop, M.A. of Dick Alfs Fly Shop. The two applicants were denied portions of their requests. The Board explained the Henry Fork licensing and that the Board has not been involved in attrition to the five limitation established in 1975, but maintained the status quo in deference to Fremont County Commissioners request; and that other unclassified rivers are non-regulated by land management. The plea bargaining offer of Attorney Benjamin for float-fishing license on the Henry's Fork and drop the pheasant hunting in Magic Valley was rejected by the Board.

Guy was asked about conflict of interest of a licensed guide also working for enforcement. Guy said no legal problem but criticism of special favor to outfitter could result. Also Board asked for attorney's advise on their decision on Mike's employment -- okay to reassign and if refused, as state personnel attorney Latta has explained, that as non-classified personnel no reason needed to terminate for insubordination but avoid age discrimination.

Guy left the meeting at 4:30 P. M. The Board then reviewed the request of Dave Burk, Pocatello through his attorney to schedule a hearing on his outfitter license denial of October, 1974.

The Board's minutes of April 16, 17, & 18, 1980 were read and approved prior to recess called at 5:15 P. M.

On Friday, June 6, 1980 the Board members Jim, Bill, Ivon and Eldon, reconvened at 8:30 A.M.; Vice-Chairman Baughman presided.

Hearing costs were discussed -- it was agreed to go back to the Legislature to have the Outfitters and Guides Law changed to put the burden of hearing costs on the complainants. Also discussed, was the transfer of areas in sales of outfitter businesses.

Then the Board discussed the office work load and Eldon mentioned he had heard good words from outfitters in their business contact with the office staff.

Outfitter applications were worked on: new applicant, John Dyer's Seven Devil's Ranch approved for summer area only -- hunting area assigned to others. 2. John Hill's South Fork Expeditions, Ltd. approved for big game hunting in Rhett Bradford's old area if the extension fee is paid. Mr. Baughman told of John Hill's explanation of a "partner's" advertising illegally for their business to conduct trailrides into lakes for fishing. 3. Dick Atchison extension was discussed for bear/cougar and deer hunting was discussed. Forest Service says okay for bear and cougar, but Harrington also licensed for same, but it's well roaded for public deer hunting. Robert Smith is requesting same area for bear and cougar hunting. No decision as yet, Ivon will check with Fish and Game. 4. Robert Smith's extension for bear and cougar approved. 5. Doug Cremer's bow hunting for bear application will be held per June 5 phone request. 6. Art Griffith application for old Jerry Spear area approved. Then Art was called by the Board prior to the lunch recess.

The four Board members reconvened at 1:15 P.M. and outfitter business was continued. 7 - Rick's College licensing on the Teton River will be denied -- all currently licensed outfitters have protested any canoe operation as it disrupts their outfitter fishing business. A hearing is needed prior to increase on licensing also. 8 - Ron Fudge (& Dexter Haymond) applicants will have an inquiry to Fish and Game on resource prior to review for approval. 9 - Tom O. Webb's application was approved as previously licensed and goose hunting. 10 - Mark Wood new M.A. at Pond's Lodge called Island Park Resorts, Inc. license was approved. 11 - Jim Powell's big game request for old Jordan area was approved with some revision of area. 12 - Waymire/Sherwood new application will have a letter written as Sherwood will need to license as an outfitter by proof of advertising received by the Board. 13 - David Williams was approved for limited deer hunting in old Featherstone area.

Then the Board worked on boating business which included approval for one of Norrick's guides, Michael R. Gehrman for boatman on the Middle Fork of the Salmon River. Richard Jones request for further exception was denied - he will be informed to follow rules. John Jones' managing agent contract with Kooyers and Salmon River Challenge being cancelled and a copy of Jones's letter to his booked guests was reviewed.

The meeting then adjourned at 4:30 P. M. A list of the licenses approved, denied, extended or amended is attached and becomes a part of these minutes.
