

OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES BOARD

Boise, Idaho

June 15, 1981

The Outfitters and Guides Board convened at 9:30 A.M., June 15, 1981, at the Board's office in Boise with Jim Baughman, Vice-Chairman, Ivol Sies and Bill Guth present.

The following business was conducted: Randy Berry telephoned about his outfitter licenses. The Board discussed with him the discrepancies in Section C: Report on Previous Season's Operation on the Teton Valley Lodge, Inc. and Randy Berry, M.A. applications. The Board informed Mr. Berry other agencies sometimes use these reports. Mr. Berry agreed to keep an accurate account of each guest for the 1981-82 license year, and report accurately on next years application. After the telephone call the Board approved the outfitter licenses for Teton Valley Lodge, Inc. and Randy Berry, M.A.

Mrs. William Heinrich called about the denial of her husband's outfitter license. She stated that she was the one who changed the date on the Red Cross card that was submitted with the application. Mrs. Heinrich said she would get a copy of the 1979 Red Cross list from Lewiston to show that her husband had taken the course on that date. The Board informed her that they would have to come to the Board meeting in July to discuss this problem.

LaVern Grussing telephoned to ask for assistance in trying to have a cable removed from across the lower Salmon River.

Dave Stucker's request for an additional hunting area was denied as the area has been licensed to another outfitter.

John Jones telephoned and requested the Board to waive the sixth trip on the Middle Fork of the Salmon River for his lead boatman license. He was informed that he must conform with the rules and regulations, and the request was denied.

Steve Guinn met with the Board and complained about an outfitter giving approval to his friends to acquire a duplicate of his license so they could use it as a buying wedge.

Mike Wilkins' report about his trip to McCall to check on outfitter Ray Ralls complaint was reviewed.

Glen Foster and Harry Vaughn telephoned to discuss Board business.

Pat Ridell met with the Board concerning Pat Silvers guide license.

Tom Webb telephoned to request the guide applications of Brad Richey and Dan Hull be returned to him as he was not going to employ them. Mr. Webb was informed the applications could not be returned as they were part of the permanent files, but they would be held in the incomplete file.

Outfitter and guide applications were reviewed for approval, denial or extensions.

The meeting adjourned at 3:00 P.M.
