Outfitters and Guides Board
Boise, Idaho

APRIL 14, 1983

At 0930, a meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Glen Foster at the Holiday Inn, Boise, Idaho. Other members present were Harry Vaughn, Norman Guth and Robert Salter. James Baughman was not in attendance.

Outfitters Ronald Vaughn, Bob and Cathy Gillihan and Scott Farr appeared before the Board, along with Big Creek District Ranger, Earl Dodds. The outfitters registered a protest on extending outfitting in the Big Creek area for summer business.

Their concern was not against Dave Stucker's past operation in Ramey Creek, but that the new proposed Big Creek Property Owners Assn. would be adding more summer business than the Cougar Basin and Monumental Creek area could handle.

A meeting of the same people with the Board at McCall, Idaho, on April 9, 1981, was cited, explaining that the agreement by all present at that meeting was there would not be more summer business licensed.

The meeting adjourned at 1005.
