Outfitters and Guides Board
Boise, Idaho

APRIL 15, 1983

On Friday, April 15, 1983, a regular meeting was called to order by Chairman James Baughman at the Outfitters and Guides Board Boise office. Other members present were Harry Vaughn and Robert Salter. Glen Foster was absent and Norman Guth had resigned.

Richard Grunch, Hayden Lake, Idaho and a proposed new partner, Bob Fuchs, of Indiana, came in to discuss their proposal to incorporate the Grunch Bunch operation, with Rick Grunch as managing agent. They also asked for a change in licensed area-- adding the balance of the old Whitecotton area in the Wallace & Avery Ranger Districts, and relinquishing area in Units 1 and 4.

Albert Lewis met with the Board about some of his cases, and the charges registered against Lee Nitz and Robert Brown.

Then Lee Nitz and Robert Brown, of Nitz Brothers, Inc., Elk City, Idaho appeared before the Board to explain their mistake in not securing out-of-state licenses for three of their Texas hunters. They explained their offer of refund of the license fees was refused, and the clients are demanding the full \$5,000.00 returned, although they received a deluxe hunt and special treatment.

The Nitz Bros. outfitters were advised that their court charges would have to be cleared before license consideration.

Joe Godsey, Boise, came in concerning his personal complaint against outfitter David J. Bream, who is billing him for expenses incurred in taking him out from a private Salmon River trip after suffering a heart attack.

Outfitter Business included review of notarized statements submitted by Marvin Todd to secure his outfitter license again, and two other letters concerning bear hunting. One from Ron Sherer, which is recinding his agreement with private hunter, John Goodner, for use of his assigned area, and one from Homer Joseph, complaining about his former guide, Dean McGuire, taking a client's fee.

Dave Stucker's request for additional bear hunting area in Units 23, 24, 32 and 32A, was reviewed, along with Fish and Game input. It was determined to license a portion of Units 23 and 24 with revision of his old area.

Other input from Fish and Game was considered in the Stanley Meholchick request for licensing elk and deer hunting in Units 33, 24 and 25. The three members determined to deny his request, citing Idaho Code 36-2109 (b), 4. & 5., but will advise him that trailrides and fishing may be added with a more definite area outlined.


Rick Vander Meyden, Heron, MT was approved for an area in Unit 4 in addition to the area he is licensed in as the managing agent in partnership with Richard Crain.

Legislator Ron Beitelspacher's letter was read which advises support would be needed for the Fish and Game Department's Pheasant Stamp bill, when it is resubmitted to the Legislature.

An itemized listing of the Board's income and expense through the month of March was reviewed, and a copy follows as a part of these minutes.

A list of licenses issued, extended, amended, and/or denied since the March 22-24, 1983 board meeting, are included as a part of these minutes.

Adjournment was called at 1700.
